



The Friends of the Waco-McLennan County Library welcomes used book dealers from across the southwest to our sale. We ask that you remember that the book sale is the primary fund-raiser for the Friends of the Library with all funds used to provide support to Waco libraries.

While dealers represent 5-10% percent of total sales, the vast majority of visitors to and sales at the Friend's sale are by individuals and families who enjoy books and support the Friends of the Library. Our desire is to balance the needs of non-dealers and dealers so that all find our event enjoyable.

To this end, dealers are asked to abide by these rules:

- Scanners may only be used at the book tables. Books may not be removed from a table and taken to another area for scanning or sorting.
- Please be careful when using a scanner so that it does not point towards another person.
- Please do not block aisles with carts.
- Please make use of the holding area; unattended books, bags, boxes will be picked-up and restocked.
- Be polite to all, but especially to seniors who may not move as quickly as you and to parents with young children in tow.
- If you fail to abide by these rules, you will be asked to leave our sale.

The entrance charge on Thursday is \$5 per adult (15 and older); there no longer is a family rate. Numbered wristband sales will begin at 8am on Thursday November 12 and each person must purchase their own wristband in-person. Please be in line by your entrance number by 9:45am.
