Boil Water Notice for Area West of Wickson Rd.

Due to a break in a main water line, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) has required the City of Waco water system to notify all customers residing along the Highway 84 corridor west of Wickson Rd. including the Meadowlands, Twin Rivers, Sun West, Harris Creek, Stone Creek, Hidden Valley, Three Kings, Riverside and River Park subdivisions, of the need to boil their water prior to consumption.

The City of Waco is issuing this precautionary notice to ensure destruction of all harmful bacteria and other microbes, water for drinking, cooking, and making ice should be boiled and cooled prior to use. The water should be brought to a vigorous, rolling boil and then boiled for two minutes. In lieu of boiling, you may purchase bottled water or obtain water from some other suitable source. When it is no longer necessary to boil the water, the water system officials will notify you that the water is safe for consumption.

Crews are working on the line and pressure established by 5pm today. Instructions to discontinue boiling will be issued in the same manner as this notice.
