The General Election for the City of Waco City Council and the Waco Independent School District Trustees will be held on Saturday, May 9. The first day to file in person for the position of City Council member for District II, District IV and District V is Monday, Feb. 9.

Candidate applications will be available in the City Secretary's Office, which is located on the first floor of City Hall, 300 Austin Ave. The City Secretary's Office is open Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.
