TIGER Grant Project Nomination Summary Form  
Completion Guidance**

**Nominating Entity:** Provide the name of the entity that is submitting the nomination and will sponsor the project (e.g. City of Waco, Hardeman County, El Paso MPO, etc.)

**Status of Environmental Review/Approval:** Provide the status of the environmental clearance review and/or approval (e.g. CE approved, EA under review by FTA, ROD received, EIS currently underway, etc.)

**Estimated Completion Date of Construction:** Provide the estimated date all construction on the project would be completed if the project were selected and approved for funding in February 2010 (e.g. August 2011)

**Estimated Total Project Cost (Design + ROW + Construction):** Provide the total project cost for all phases of the project even if some of them have already been completed (e.g. Total design + ROW + construction costs = \$31 million)

**Estimated TIGER Grant funds being Requested:** Provide the total amount of eligible project costs that will be sought from the TIGER Grant program. Only include costs that are eligible, that have not already been spent, and that will not be spent prior to the project being selected for the TIGER Grant program

**Type of Project:** Check the appropriate type of project

**Selection Criteria:** Check the appropriate selection criteria the project achieves and provide a brief description of the benefits the project provides for those criteria (e.g. State of Good Repair – this project will reconstruct poorly deteriorated pavement and bridges on SH 224 and provide a service life of the reconstructed facility of 40 years, Livability – this project will provide enhanced transit service connecting downtown San Antonio to the medical center allowing employees and patients to live and work in these population centers without having to drive to commute)
