RESOLUTIONS

1. **RES-171** – Consider approval of a resolution that:
 - 1) Amends the designated polling locations for the General Election in and throughout the City of Waco on **Saturday, May 8, 2010**;
 - 2) Amends the Contract for Election Services with the McLennan County Elections Administrator;
 - 3) Amends the Joint Election Agreement between the City of Waco, Waco Independent School District, and McLennan County;
 - 4) Designates election officials, establishes a rate of pay and provides for other matters relating to the general election, in an amount not to exceed \$59,816.00; and
 - 5) Authorizes the City Manager to complete all documents necessary to complete these transactions.

ORDINANCES

2. **ORD-172** – Consider approval of an ordinance amending Section 25-133 in Article VI in Chapter 25, "Traffic And Vehicles," of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Waco, McLennan County, Texas, to set a speed limit of 35 mph on New Road from Cobbs Drive to W. Waco Drive, a distance of 1.661 mile, and to retain the speed limit of 40 mph on New Road from W. Waco Drive to the Waco-Beverly Hills common city limits near the MK&T Railway, being a distance of 0.667 mile.
