Boil Water Notice for FM 185 Area

Due to low chlorine residuals, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) has required the City of Waco water system (PWS#1550008) to notify all customers residing along FM 185 from FM 1637 to the 185 bridge of the need to boil their water prior to consumption. This is a precautionary notice due to low chlorine residuals.

To ensure destruction of all harmful bacteria and other microbes, water for drinking, cooking, and making ice should be boiled and cooled prior to use. The water should be brought to a vigorous, rolling boil and then boiled for two minutes. In lieu of boiling, you may purchase bottled water or obtain water from some other suitable source.

When it is no longer necessary to boil the water, the water system officials will notify you that the water is safe for consumption. Instructions to discontinue boiling will be issued in the same manner as this notice.
