Boil Water Notice Lifted for Part of Old Lorena Rd. at Spring Valley Rd. Area

The boil water notice, previously issued by the City of Waco water system (PWS#1550008), for customers residing along (including all adjoining roads): Chapel Rd., from Belver Rd. east to Farmiller Rd., along Spring Valley Rd., from Old Lorena Rd. east to the city limits of Hewitt and along Old Lorena Rd. from Spring Valley Rd. north to Haley Hill Rd., is lifted for customers east of Old Lorena Rd and all customers north of Longhorn Dr., effective immediately.

The Boil Water Notice remains in effect, however, for customers residing west of Old Lorena Rd. and south of Longhorn Dr, including those residing on: Armadillo Rd., Belver Rd., Bluebonnet Ln., Crooked Creek Rd., Eaglecrest, Fox Ridge Rd., Longhorn Dr., Lorena Meadows Dr., Marcy Ln., Mourning Dove Ln., Old Lorena Rd. (west side), Pence Dr., Possum's End and Rabbit Hill.

The mandatory no outdoor water use restriction remains in effect for the entire area and conservation between the hours 6:00 p.m. – 10:00 p.m. remains important.

The boil water notice was originally issued on August 6, due to low water pressure.
