Boil Water Notice/Outdoor Water Use Ban for Old Lorena Rd. at Spring Valley Rd. Area Lifted for All Customers

Waco, Texas (August 14, 2015) – The boil water notice, previously issued by the City of Waco water system (PWS#1550008), for customers residing along (including all adjoining roads): Chapel Rd., from Belver Rd. east to Farmiller Rd., along Spring Valley Rd., from Old Lorena Rd. east to the city limits of Hewitt and along Old Lorena Rd. from Spring Valley Rd. north to Haley Hill Rd., is now lifted for all customers, including those residing west of Old Lorena Rd. and south of Longhorn Dr., effective immediately.

Previously, on August 11, the boil water notice was lifted for customers east of Old Lorena Rd and customers north of Longhorn Dr.

The water for the entire area now meets all state and federal drinking water criteria and residents may discontinue boiling water.

Additionally, effective immediately, the City of Waco is cancelling the mandatory no outdoor water use restriction in this area. However, residents should continue to conserve water use whenever possible, particularly during the heavy usage hours of 6:00 p.m. – 10:00 p.m.

The boil water notice was originally issued on August 6, due to low water pressure.
