**City of Waco 4<sup>th</sup> of July Holiday Closings**

Waco, Texas (June 29, 2015) – City of Waco offices will be closed on Friday, July 3<sup>rd</sup> in observance of our nation’s July 4<sup>th</sup> Independence Day. Details follow concerning some specific services and departments:

The Solid Waste offices and Cobbs Recycling Center will be closed on Saturday, July 4<sup>th</sup>. The landfill will be closed to the public on Friday, July 3<sup>rd</sup>, but will accept franchise haulers up to 4:30 p.m. Friday’s trash will be picked up on Friday as usual.

The Waco-McLennan County Library system will close all four libraries on Friday, July 3<sup>rd</sup>, and will reopen on Monday, July 6<sup>th</sup>. (Please note: East Waco Library will remain closed for renovations until further notice.)

Waco Transit will run regular service on Friday, July 3<sup>rd</sup> and will be closed on Saturday, July 4<sup>th</sup>. The Transit Department will provide a bus shuttle from Heritage Square and the Ferrell Center to the Pedestrian Bridge beginning at 5:30 p.m. on July 4<sup>th</sup> to carry “Fourth on the Brazos” celebrants to and from the event.

Cameron Park Zoo, the Waco Mammoth Site, and the Texas Ranger Hall of Fame & Museum will remain open on Friday, July 3<sup>rd</sup> and Saturday, July 4<sup>th</sup>.
