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## **Flat Creek Flood Study – 3rd Public Meeting Set for October 19**

Waco, Texas (June 2, 2016) – The Cities of Waco, Robinson, Hewitt and Woodway invite citizens to attend a second public meeting to hear and give input on plans for Flat Creek flood planning. The meeting will be held on Wednesday, October 19 from 5:30 to 6:30 p.m. at Midway High School’s Distance Learning Center (8200 Mars Dr.).

The City of Waco, in conjunction with the cities of Robinson, Hewitt, and Woodway, received a Flood Protection Planning grant from the Texas Water Development Board to conduct a study of Flat Creek to develop both short term and long term recommendations for flood damage reduction and flood warning measures.

This is the second in a series of public meetings to present results and receive public input. The purpose of the meeting will be to go over new, preliminary floodplain maps for Flat Creek based upon updated Hydrology and new, surveyed cross sections.
