FOURTH ON THE BRAZOS, H-E-B FIREWORKS SET FOR FRIDAY IN DOWNTOWN WACO

Waco, Texas (July 1, 2014) – The City of Waco’s annual Fourth on the Brazos celebration and the H-E-B Fireworks Extravaganza will take place Thursday at Indian Spring Park in downtown Waco.

Approximately 15,000 people are expected to attend the event. Entertainment will begin at 7 p.m. and the fireworks show is scheduled for 10 p.m. The concert and fireworks are free to the public.

Entertainment will include rock and roll classics and traditional patriotic music:

Other attractions include a food court, kayaking on the Brazos, and a kids’ arts area. Coolers, blankets and chairs are allowed in the park. Tents, pets, glass bottles, grills, and fireworks of any kind are not allowed.

Downtown streets around the event will close at 7 p.m.; however, free parking is available throughout downtown. No parking is allowed on street medians.
