FOURTH ON THE BRAZOS MOVES TO TOUCHDOWN ALLEY, H-E-B FIREWORKS AT 9:15 P.M.

Waco, Texas (June 26, 2015) – The City of Waco’s annual Fourth on the Brazos celebration will move to McLane Stadium’s Touchdown Alley on Saturday, July 4, and the H-E-B Fireworks Extravaganza will take place at 9:15 p.m.

Approximately 15,000 people are expected to attend the event at the new location. Gates will open at 6 p.m. The event, which will feature live music, food trucks and family fun, is free to the public.

Entertainment will include the Corndog Classic eating championship, rock and roll classics and traditional patriotic music:

Main Stage

- 7:15 p.m. Fourth Annual Corndog Classic
- 7:30 p.m. LC Rocks tribute band (Austin, Texas)
- 9:10 p.m. National Anthem and Waco Community Band

H-E-B Fireworks Extravaganza

- 9:15 p.m. to 9:30 p.m. Presented by H-E-B

Free parking will be available at McLane Stadium (enter Lot B and C), the Ferrell Center and Heritage Square in Downtown Waco. Parking will also be available in city-owned lots and along city streets where permitted. No parking is allowed on bridges or street medians.

Waco Transit will run free shuttles from 5:30 p.m. to 10:30 p.m. The shuttles will pick up at the Ferrell Center and Heritage Square. Riders will be dropped off at the entrance of Baylor Law School and will walk across the Umphrey Bridge to the event site. Handicap parking is available at Lot D of McLane Stadium.

Coolers, blankets, umbrellas and chairs are allowed in the park. Large tents, pets, glass bottles, grills, and fireworks are not allowed.
