### **RIBBON-CUTTING CEREMONY SET FOR 10 A.M. WEDNESDAY AT SELEY PARK**

Waco, Texas (November 7, 2016) – The City of Waco Parks and Recreation Department will host a ribbon-cutting ceremony at 10 a.m. Wednesday for the renovations of Seley Park.

Seley Park is located at 1800 Bosque Blvd. Since 2013, the park has undergone two phases of construction and \$665,000 of improvements. The project was funded by 75% Grants, 20% CIP, and 5% Community Partnership.

#### **Phase 1: \$330,000 (2013 - 2015)**

- Accessibility Improvements: parking, paved walking loop, pavilion ramp, picnic area
- Six Adult Fitness Stations (by donation)
- Drinking Fountain (by donation)
- New swing set and 2-5 and 5-12 age appropriate playgrounds with new curbs, drainage, accessible ramps

#### **Phase 2: \$335,000 (2016)**

- New electrical infrastructure supporting an irrigation system and site lighting
- Relocated and new multi-use court with a basketball half-court
- New fence along Bosque Boulevard
- Renovation of the Seley Park Gazebo to include structural repairs, new roof, paint, and benches
