Sidewalk Collapse Changes Traffic on North Bound Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd Near East Herring Ave

A sidewalk has collapsed near the intersection of East Herring Avenue and Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd. Both water and waste water pipes are in the area and the cause is being investigated. Traffic in the area is being rerouted (see route information below) until the repairs can be made. After determining the cause, estimates to repair the sidewalk and the street could take up to seven days.

Citizens are asked to avoid the area to minimize traffic congestion during the repair. When the repairs are complete and the streets are reopened, we will issue an update release.

Traffic Detour Information:

North bound traffic on MLK Blvd (coming from I-35) will be routed on to Faulkner Lane, left on Dallas then left on Herring and then turn right back on to MLK Blvd.(see map below)

All other traffic East and West bound traffic on Herring Ave, and South bound traffic on MLK Blvd will not be affected.
