**Street Rehabilitation Underway for Locations Around Waco**

Waco, Texas (August 2, 2016) – As part of the City of Waco’s annual street rehabilitation program, pavement rehabilitation has begun on some of the roadways in and around area neighborhoods.

The milling, overlay and reclamation project will perform preventative maintenance of the streets to extend the life of the roadway. The duration of construction citywide is approximately 90 working days.

During construction, drivers may experience inconveniences such as equipment noise, dust, reduction of street parking and temporary lane or road closures.

Milling and overlay are part of the City’s preventive maintenance program for the street network. The milling process removes the top portion of the deteriorated pavement and provides a textured surface for a better mechanical interlock with the new overlay of hot-mix asphalt layer placed and compacted to a depth of approximately 2 inches.

Reclamation is part of the City’s rehabilitation program for the street network. The reclamation process restores the strength of the underlying pavement structure and is completed with a compacted depth of approximately 2 inches of hot-mix asphalt. All of these streets will receive new pavement markings.
