Beginning September 1st, 2014 Waco Police to Enforce new Parking Ordinance

The Waco City Council recently enacted City ordinance # 2014-296. Beginning September 1st, owners of certain vehicles can no longer legally park these vehicles on a street, alley or public right-of-way inside of residential districts. Some of those vehicles include the following:

Commercial Vehicles, Trailers, Boats and Boat Trailers, Truck Tractor, RV's, House Trailers and Farm Tractors.
