Efficient Water Use and Irrigation Meeting Set for South Waco Community Center

Waco, Texas (Nov. 11, 2011) – The public is invited to attend a seminar in regards to the current drought and efficient water use. The free meeting will be held from 10 a.m. to noon Nov. 15 at South Waco Community Center. (2815 Speight).

Forecasters predict that the drought is likely to continue into 2012. Municipalities and water districts are having to make difficult decisions regarding who gets water and how much should be allocated. Water for crop, turfgrass and landscape irrigation will almost certainly be among the first areas to be considered for reductions.

This meeting is to discuss how best to deal with the issue and to examine irrigation practices to help conserve water for our community in the most responsible manner possible. If you use water for the irrigation of plants this is a meeting you should attend.

The meeting will include representatives from the United States Golf Association, City of Waco, KXXV-25, Texas Agrilife Extension Service, and McLennan County Master Gardeners.
