

Any person who is or who appears to be ill cannot prepare food, serve food or work with food equipment.




Fingernails must be clean, maintained, trimmed and smooth.


Unless wearing intact gloves in good repair, a food employee may not wear fingernail polish or artificial fingernails.



All persons engaged in food preparation or food handling must wear clean clothing.




All jewelry on the hands or arms is prohibited with the exception of a plain (unadorned, unengraved) wedding band.



Aprons must be kept clean and must not be taken into, nor worn in restrooms. Aprons should be changed if worn while handling trash and must be changed if they become soiled.



Wash hands properly: use warm water, soap, 20 seconds of scrubbing, a fingernail brush and dry with a paper towel or air dryer.



Tobacco use, eating or chewing gum is not allowed while preparing food.

A drink is allowed if it is in a covered container, is handled to prevent contamination of hands, and is not stored on food contact surfaces.



All persons preparing food SHALL (not might, not may, not if they want to) wear EFFECTIVE hair restraints.
