About The Health District

At the Waco-McLennan County Public Health District, protecting the community's health is our mission. We want to support individuals in receiving appropriate health care.

The Health District serves a population of more than 220,000 in and around McLennan County. Examples of the services we provide include health education, nutrition counseling, dental care, disease control, immunizations, HIV-AIDS services, sexually transmitted disease treatment, birth and death records and environmental health inspections.

The Health District, a department within the City of Waco organization, is affiliated with the Department of State Health Services and is funded by grants, governmental entities, Medicare, Medicaid and user fees.

Utility Payments

City of Waco water customers can make utility payments from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. at the cashier's window on the first floor of the Health District, 225 West Waco Drive.

Health District Services

Environmental Health

The Environmental Health Division protects citizens through food safety and food manager classes; public health nuisance complaint investigations and abatement; Inspections of swimming pools, spas and day care facilities; and physical inspections of all restaurants, grocery stores, convenience stores and other establishments where food is served, sold or stored.

Epidemiology & Surveillance

Epidemiology & Surveillance monitors and analyzes the distribution of infectious and chronic disease within McLennan County and the factors that influence this distribution. This is accomplished through disease surveillance, both active and passive, disease investigation, and statistical analysis. Epidemiology also aides in the implementation of measures to control and prevent the spread of communicable diseases.

Health Education

Health Education provides screening, literature, and education for the community on various health topics through the Public Health District Speakers Bureau to aid in the prevention of chronic diseases and promote healthy lifestyles.

HIV-AIDS Services

HIV-AIDS Services provides free and confidential HIV antibody testing; prevention and education programs; and direct client services, including dental assistance with prescriptions and housing facilities for qualified clients. HIV-AIDS Services assists clients in Bosque, Falls, Freestone, Hill, Limestone and McLennan Counties.

Immunization

Immunization provides childhood, adult and foreign travel shots. Services are provided on-site at the Health District or may be arranged at various locations throughout the county.

Laboratory Services

Laboratory staff perform testing to assist the HIV/ STD Clinics and Public Health Nursing Division. Walk-in pregnancy tests are also available. the division.

Health District Services

Public Health Nursing

Public Health Nursing provides various services to include immunization audits for day-care centers and schools to ensure compliance with federal, state and local laws and requirements; serve as preceptors for students and practicing professionals interested in Public Health Nursing and provide nursing support to other program areas within

Public Health Preparedness

Public Health Preparedness provides coordinated public health system response plans for bioterrorism and other public health threats, both manmade and natural in origin, ensuring these plans are coordinated with local, regional and state partners. Staff also manages training opportunities for medical and other emergency response professionals and volunteers.

Sexually Transmitted Disease Clinic

Clinic staff provide treatment for sexually transmitted diseases (STDs) such as syphilis, gonorrhea and chlamydia. Clinic staff seek to minimize the spread of the disease in the community through education. The clinic staff also review laboratory reports of STDs from other labs in McLennan County.

Tuberculosis Control

Tuberculosis Control provides care to residents diagnosed with active Tuberculosis as well as those who have been exposed to active cases. Services include screenings, medical evaluation, chest x-rays, medication and follow-up.

Women, Infants & Children Nutrition Program (WIC)

WIC is a supplemental nutrition program for working and nonworking families who meet income, residency and health screening requirements. Food vouchers for grocery store use, nutrition classes are provided. WIC Clinics are located in Waco, Mart, McGregor, Waco Headstart Center and on the TSTC campus.

Vital Statistics

The Vital Statistics Division maintains birth and death records for the City of Waco. The division also provides certified copies of birth certificates to all native Texans through a computer link to the state bureau in Austin.
