**Chief Stroman releases statement on guilty verdict and punishment of suspect that shot Officer Mrosko.**

The trial and punishment phase in the Noy Moten trial in 54<sup>th</sup> District Court have been completed. Moten is charged with Enhanced Aggravated Assault on a Peace Officer in the September 2007 incident that left Moten and Waco Police Officer Craig Mrosko wounded. Today jurors returned a guilty verdict and sentenced Moten to life in prison.

Upon hearing the verdict, Chief Stroman said, "I would like to thank the jury for their service in reaching this important guilty verdict. The verdict echoes the support the Waco Police Department receives from the citizens of Waco on a daily basis. Officer Mrosko and the other men and women of the Waco Police Department provide an unyielding defense against criminal activity by placing their lives on the line every day. The aggressive prosecution by the McLennan County District Attorney's office and the verdict rendered by the jury show that the Waco community value that service."
