

CITY OF WACO Solid Waste Services

“Keeping Waco Clean and Green”

Provided weekly:

1. Curbside collection of one grey trash cart
2. A second trash cart is available for an extra charge of \$4/month.

Provided every other week:

1. The blue (recycling) and green (yard waste) carts are collected on alternating weeks on the same collection day as the trash.
2. Residents are provided, at their request, one 95 gallon blue (recycling) and one green (yard waste) carts at no extra charge.
3. A second recycling or yard waste cart is available for an extra charge of \$4/month.

Provided at your request:

1. Curbside bulky waste service

- Residential Solid Waste Services include the free pickup of one 5'x 4'x 4' (maximum) bulky waste pile. Charges apply to larger piles.
- Please call Solid Waste Customer Service at (254) 299-2612 to request bulky collection.
- Examples of bulky waste include furniture, mattresses, limited amounts of remodeling debris, appliances.
- Bulky waste only includes materials generated by residents, defined as those who occupy a home and pay for solid waste services via their water bill.
- To arrange for collection of materials generated by commercial sources (i.e., contractors and businesses), from tenant evictions, or vacant lots, please call 299-2612. Collection of those materials is only done for a fee.

2. Curbside brush collection

- Residential Solid Waste Services include the free pickup of one 5'x 4'x 4' (maximum) brush waste pile which was generated by residents, defined as those who occupy a home and pay for solid waste services via their water bill.
- Please call Solid Waste Customer Service at (254) 299-2612 to request brush collection. Charges apply to larger piles.
- Branches should be cut to no longer than 5 feet long.
- To arrange for collection of materials generated by commercial sources (i.e., contractors and businesses), from tenant evictions, or vacant lots, please call 299-2612. Collection of those materials is only done for a fee.

Additional Services:

1. Access to the municipal landfill at 11400 Old McGregor Road.

- Landfill hours of operation are Monday-Friday from 8:00 AM until 4:30 PM; Saturday for 8:00 AM until 11:30 AM. The landfill is closed on Sunday and some city holidays.
- Waco Residents may self-haul to the landfill twice per month and dispose of up to 2,000 pounds free of charge.
- Residents must provide proof of City residency by presenting their current water utility bill (showing residential garbage service) and driver's license with a matching address. No photo copies or delinquent bills will be accepted.
- Amounts in excess of 2,000 pounds and/or after the second trip in a month, may be disposed of based on the standard disposal fee. Payment must be made at the time of disposal.

2. Access to the Cobbs Recycling Center at 2021 44th Street, between Cobbs Drive and Trice Avenue.

- Cobbs Recycling Center hours of operation are Tuesday- Saturday from 8:00 AM until 5:00 PM; Cobbs is closed on Sunday, Monday and some city holidays.
- Waco residents may use this center for brush and bulky waste disposal, and extended recycling services.
- Brush and bulky items can be brought to the center with proof of residency to dispose of materials twice per month. The following guidelines apply to brush and bulky waste drop-offs:
 - Two drop-offs per month are permitted.
 - State law requires that loose loads must be tarped.
 - Because of liability concerns, City of Waco staff cannot help unload.
 - Extended recycling services include glass recycling, computers and peripherals, batteries, used motor oil, antifreeze, oil filters and latex paint. Some of these items require proof of residency.

3. Periodic Household Hazardous Waste Collection Days, Scrap Tire Collection Days, and Neighborhood Clean-up Days

1, 2, 3 SWEEP (Solid Waste Education and Enforcement Program)

Residents must comply with these three simple requirements:

- All trash must be in the trash cart. Garbage bags, trash, or personal trash cans should not be placed beside the trash cart.
- All trash must be bagged before putting it the cart to avoid windblown trash.
- Personal trash cans should not be placed at the curb for collection.
