

**CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION
RESULTS OF POLICE SERGEANT (GRADE II) PRE-QUALIFYING EXAM**

The following list of candidates took the pre-qualifying, written examination for **Police Sergeant (Grade II)** on **April 6, 2023**. A minimum score of 70 on the written exam shall be considered passing. Those not passing the written exam shall be eliminated from further consideration regarding the Assessment Center process.

Candidates passing the written test with a minimum score of 70 will move on to the Assessment Center portion of the examination. The Assessment Center will be conducted by Steve Griffith Consulting on **April 28, 2023**, at the M.C.C. Emergency Services Education Center and will start at **8:00 a.m.**

Candidates will be placed on an eligibility list according to their total score, highest to lowest, derived from the combination of the following – Written Exam @ 60 points, Assessment Center @ 40 points, Seniority in Rank @ a maximum of 10 points, Military Service with Honorable Discharge or Associate's Degree @ 1 point, Bachelor's Degree or Master Peace Officer License @ 2 points and Master's Degree @ 3 points (total maximum score 113). Candidates are eligible only for the highest educational/certification/military points for which they qualify. Candidates must have a cumulative score of 70% or higher from adding the written test score with the assessment center score to be eligible for promotion.

NOTE – Only the test score (not including years of service seniority and education points) is being posted at this time. Ties are listed alphabetically.
