STORYWALK AT DEWEY COMMUNITY CENTER

WACO, TEXAS (August 23, 2022) – The Waco-McLennan Library is hosting a StoryWalk at Dewey Community Center (925 N. 9th St.) on Thursday, August 25th at 9:30 a.m. A StoryWalk is a fun, educational, healthy way for children and parents to read a book by walking from page to page along a trail. The pages are secured to a stake about 10 feet apart, and kids walk to each one to finish the story.

The Children’s Librarians will help guide guests along the path. The book that is currently displayed is “Say What?” A book about baby animals and the ways they communicate. There will be Gelu Italian Ice, Booker the Elephant, and Sparky the Fire Dog to enjoy the fun with the kids.

This installation isn’t a one-visit-only attraction. The Library plans to switch the books seasonally. Future plans include library staff hosting story times and special events to highlight this new and unique feature in the park as this is the first StoryWalk in the city of Waco.

This StoryWalk was made possible by the Texas State Library and Archives Commission (TSLAC) under its Texas Reads grant program.
