## **Boil Water Notice Rescinded**

### **Boil Water Notice for Businesses on State Highway 6/Loop 340, from State Highway 84 East to Beverly Drive Area Rescinded**

**WACO, TEXAS (July 21, 2022)** – On July 19, 2022, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality required the City of Waco to issue a Boil Water Notice to inform customers, individuals, or employees that due to conditions that occurred recently in the public water system, the water from this public water system was required to be boiled prior to use for drinking water or human consumption purposes.

The public water system has taken the necessary corrective actions to restore the quality of the water distributed by this public water system used for drinking water or human consumption purposes and has provided TCEQ with laboratory test results that indicate that the water no longer requires boiling prior to use as of July 21, 2022.
