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## **COMMUNITY ASSESSMENT FOR PUBLIC HEALTH TO BE HELD IN McLENNAN COUNTY**

**WACO, TEXAS (OCTOBER 3, 2022)** – On October 7 and 8, the Waco-McLennan County Public Health District will have survey teams traveling to randomly selected neighborhoods across McLennan County to conduct door-to-door surveys asking about health concerns, gaps in services, and other factors that may contribute the health status of residents. With growing health threats today, it's important for public health officials to know the health concerns of the community.

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention developed a door-to-door survey method that will be used for the survey called a Community Assessment for Public Health Emergency Response (CASPER). The data collected from these surveys will provide the Waco-McLennan County Public Health District and local stakeholders with a better understanding of the community's needs.

Survey teams will be made up of Health District staff members. The survey will not be used to collect any personal health information and will only be conducted during daylight hours on October 7 and 8. All survey teams will be wearing brightly colored, clearly marked Public Health T-shirts and their City of Waco ID badge.
