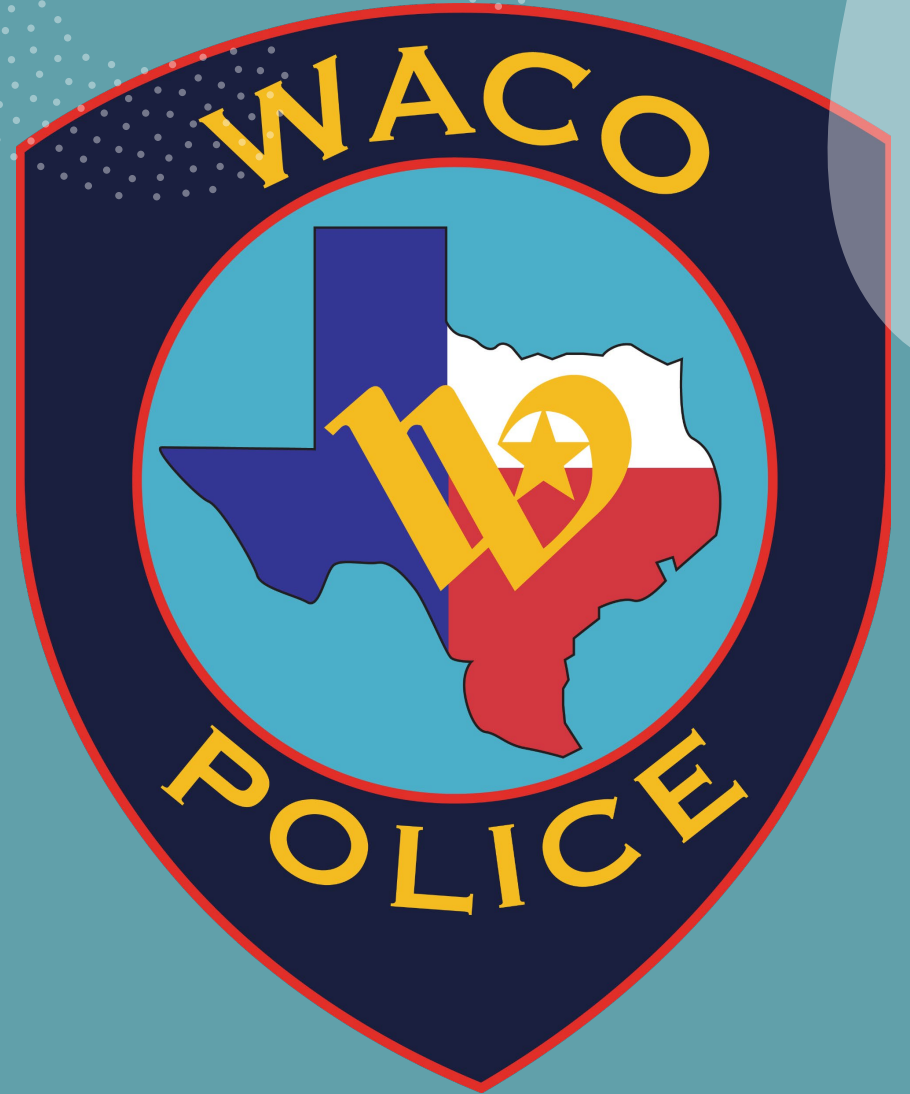

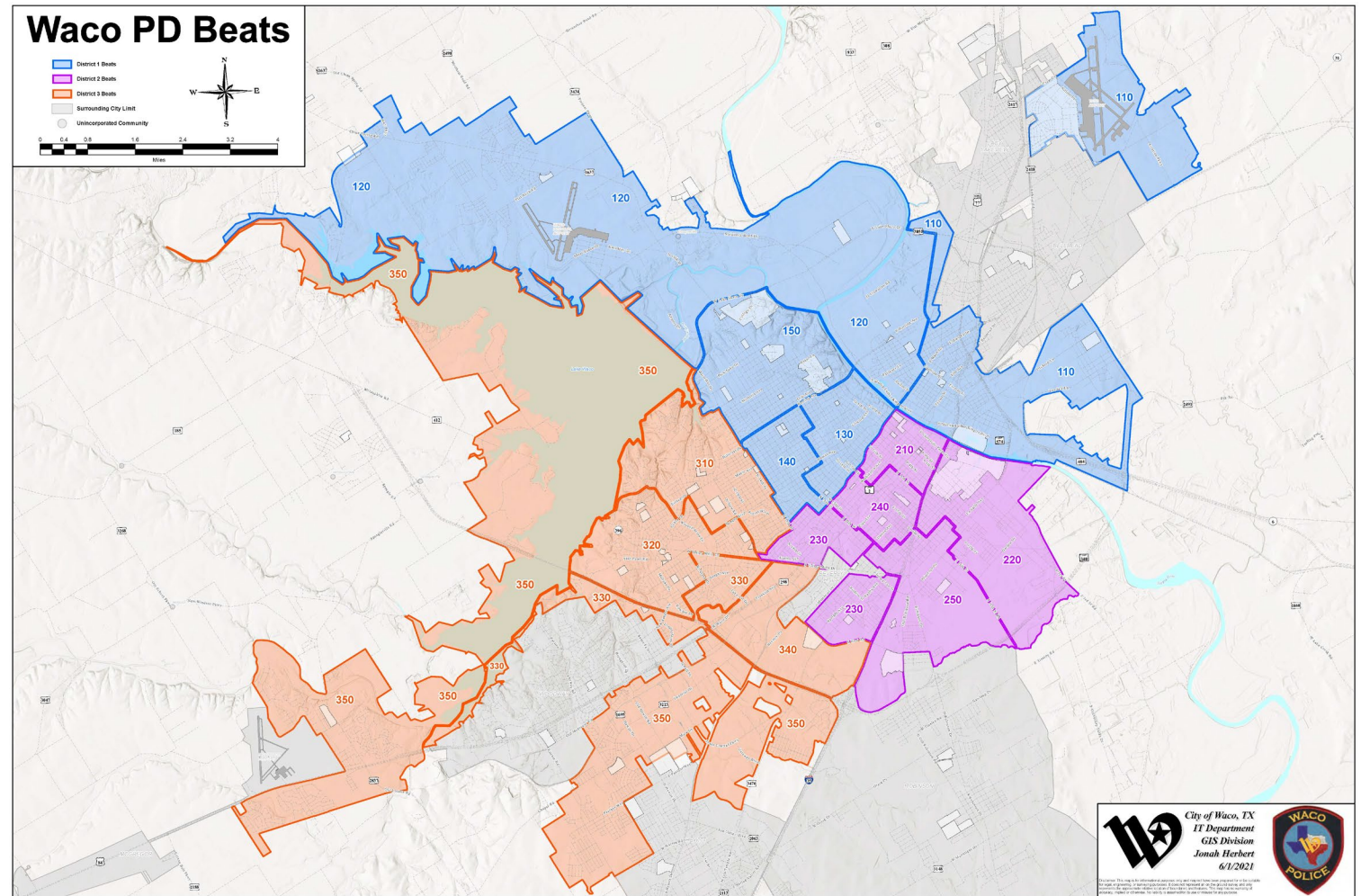

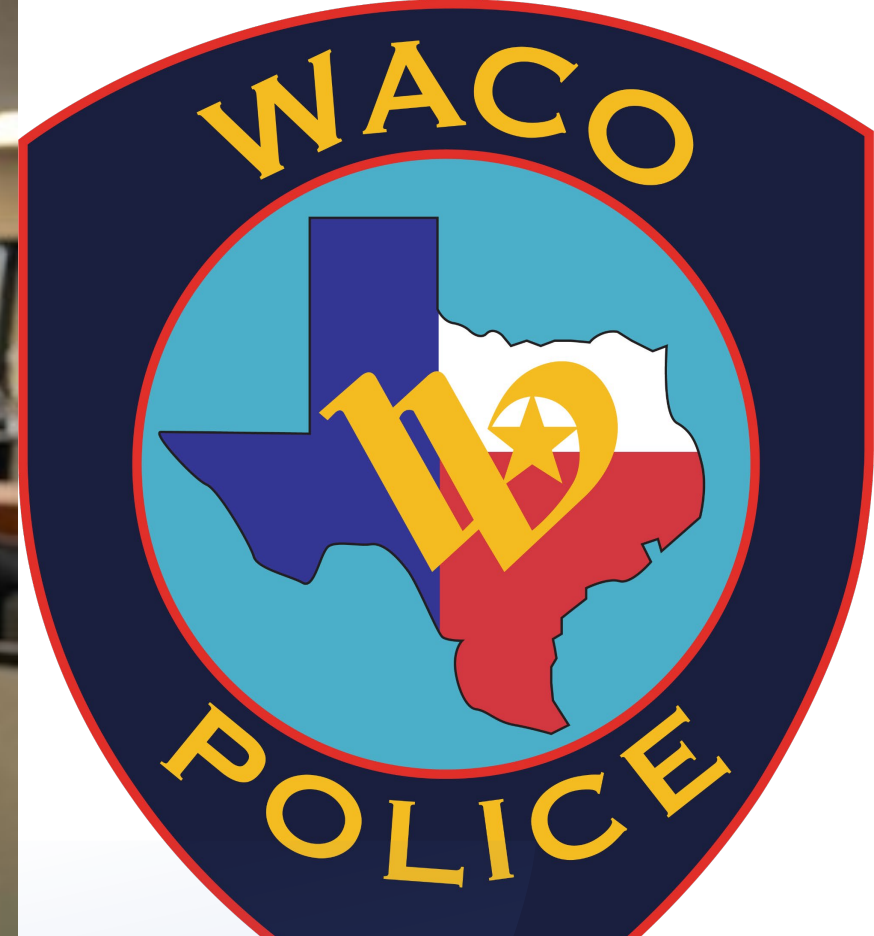

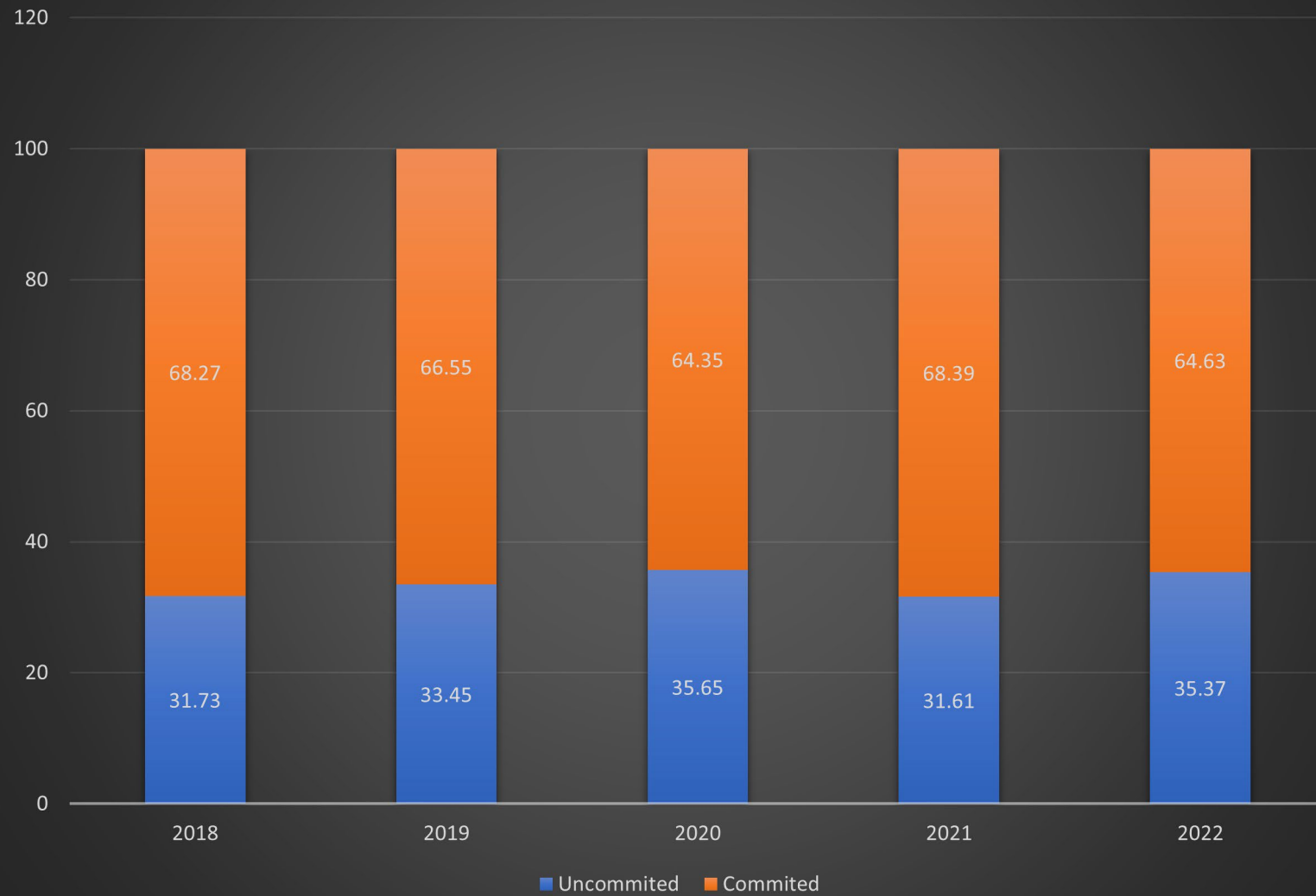
Response Time Overview

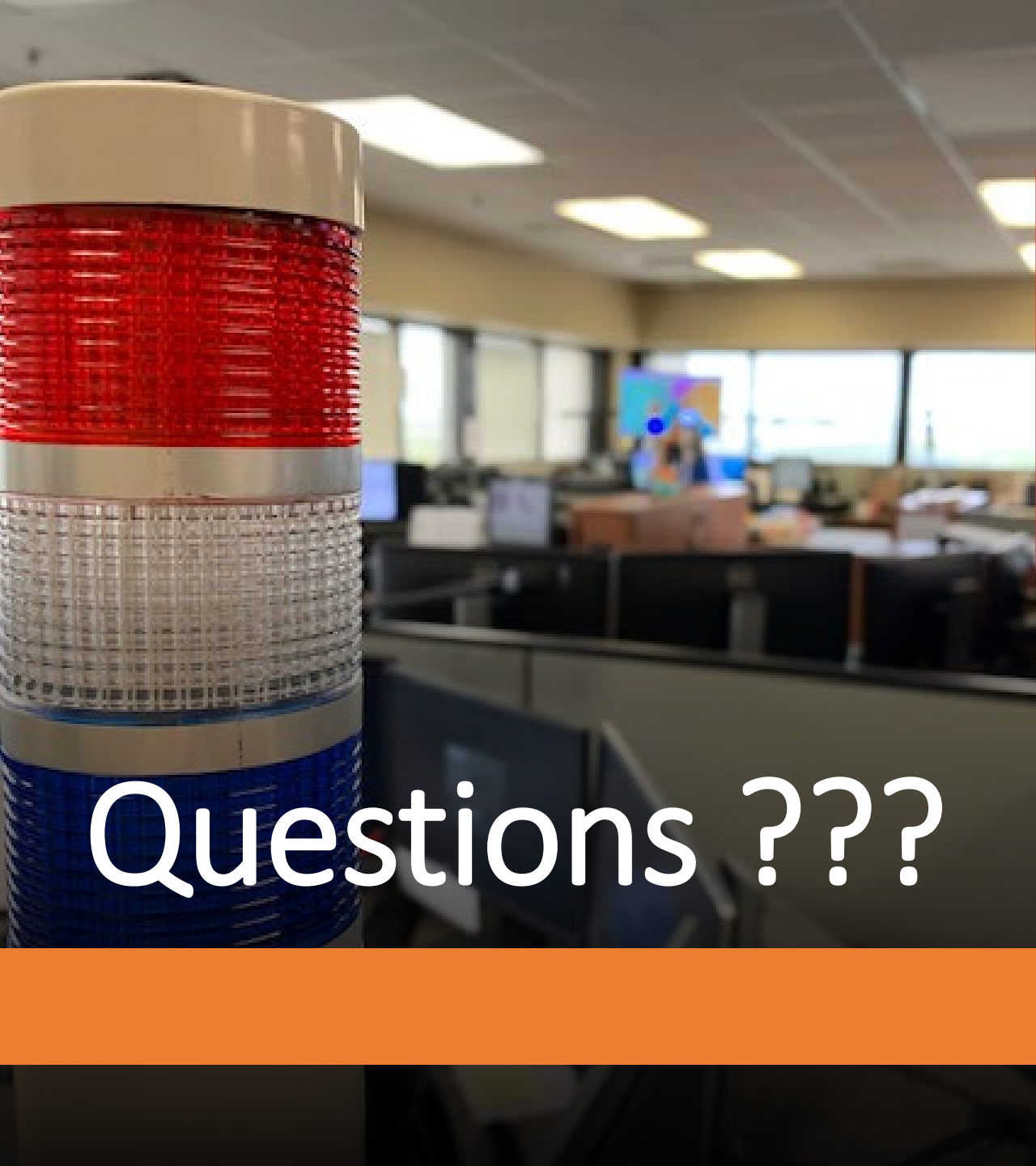
