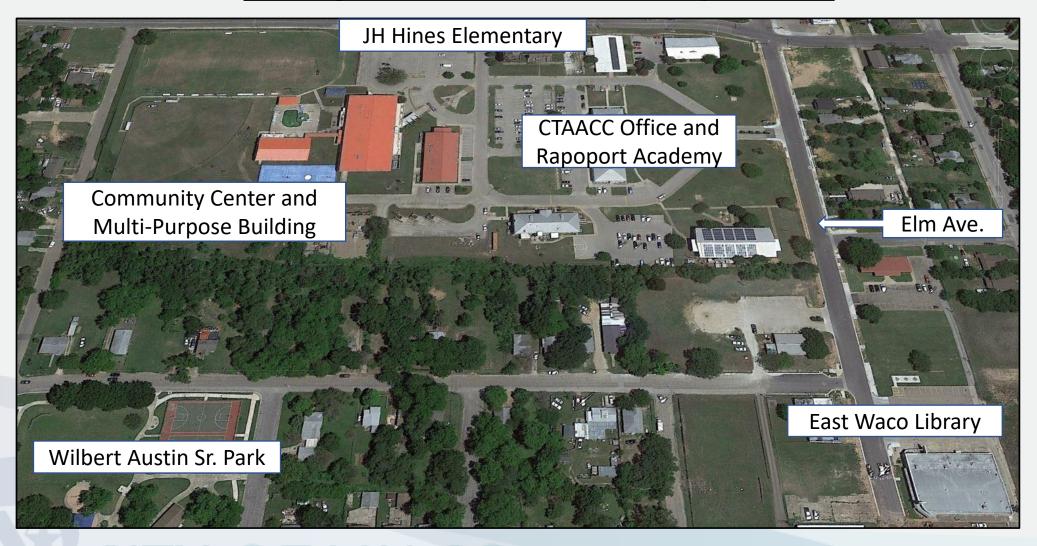

Overview of Project

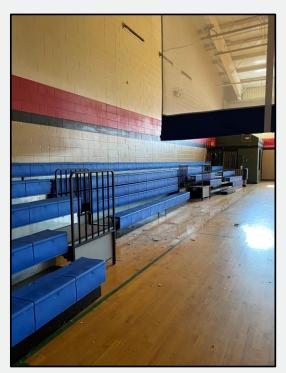
- Community Center purchased from YMCA in October 2021 (\$2.7 million)
- City purchased buildings from YMCA and assumed land lease with Paul Quinn Campus. New lease has been sent to Paul Quinn Board for review.
- Use Agreement with Rapoport Academy for interior use of building was in place for 2021-2022 school year.
- Collaboration between Facilities and Parks and Recreation:
 - Perform maintenance, repairs and improvements to the buildings
 - Create public grounds and renovate outdoor recreational amenities
- Transition of programming and staff from Bledsoe-Miller to Doris Miller

- Staff has engaged with KAI Enterprises for:
 - Community center planning
 - Aquatic consultation
 - Schematic park design and amenities
 - Community engagement
 - Connectivity



Looking Ahead at Pools

- Both pools need to be brought to code for accessibility and drainage systems
- Indoor pool in fair condition; activation for swim lessons and swim classes
 - Replace insulation, corroding metal, heating system, ventilation system and garage doors in the indoor pool building
- Will work with KAI team to redesign outdoor pool, enhance safety and accessibility

Improvement Budget Overview

Buildings include 33,500 square feet

- \$59.70 / sq ft Estimated improvement costs
- \$140.30 /sq ft Estimated improvement costs AND building purchase

\$1.4 million initial allocation for interior rehabilitation

- Approximately \$200k Renovation Expenses to Date
- Upcoming Major Expenditures and Estimates
 - \$800k to \$1 million HVAC/Boiler System
 - \$100k Indoor Pool Building
 - \$100k Furnishings and Equipment
 - \$75k Flooring
 - \$60k Painting
 - \$40k Water Heaters
- \$2 million Current Interior Budget Estimate

\$2.5 million of CIP funds allocated for outdoor renovation

- Approximately 9.5 acres in lease area
- Working with KAI for cost estimates for indoor pool improvements, outdoor pool redesign, playground replacement, sports court and field reconfiguration
