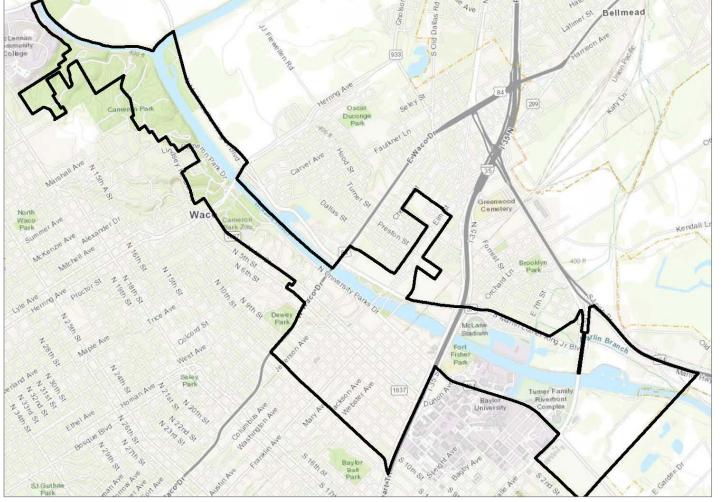

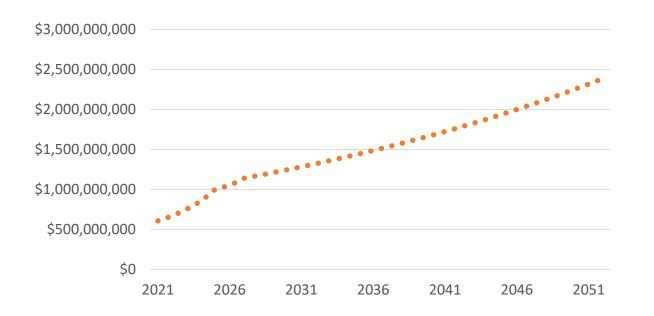

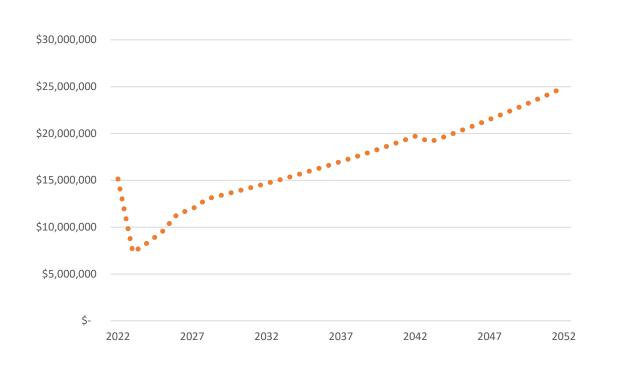

Annual Revenues

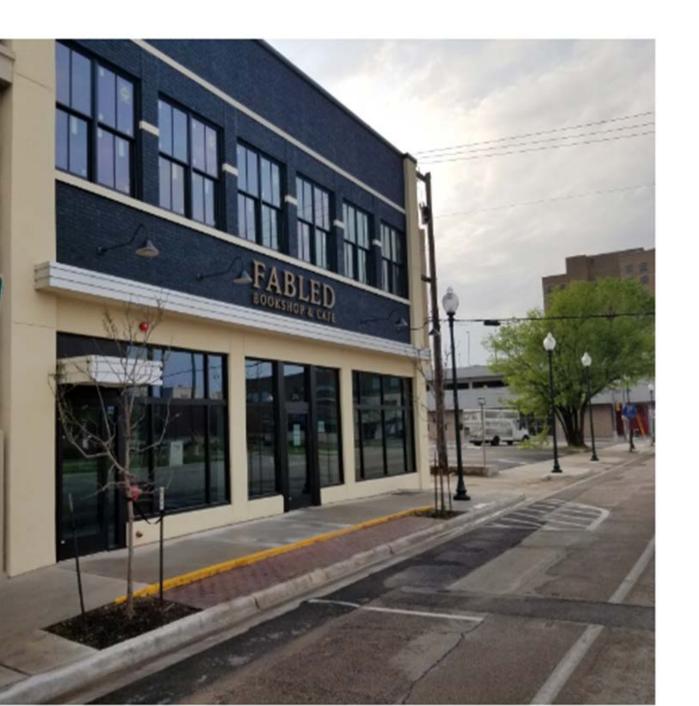


PROJECTED REVENUES
