



- From January 23, 2020 through March 16, 2020, 30 individuals in McLennan County have been tested for COVID-19.
- Twelve (12) tested negative and 18 are pending results.

• Out of the 30 tests, 17 were conducted by the DSHS and/or CDC lab. The remaining 13 were conducted using commercial labs.
