





- Allocation \$1,336,582

- Administration Cap 20% \$273,316

- Net Available \$1,093,266

 HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME) – used to create affordable housing for low-income households.

- Allocation \$715,679

- Administration Cap 10% \$71,568

- Net Available \$644,111
