Fairground Area Property Exchange Introduction






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Fairground Area Property Exchange McLennan County's Venue Project

- Maximize Economic Impact for Community
- Serve the Needs of City and School District
 - Funded with a Venue Tax of Hotels and Rental Cars

Formal Action To-Date

- <u>2015</u>: ILA for Venue-Area Master Plan
- <u>2017</u>: Voter Approval of Tax & Project
- <u>2017</u>: ILA for Property Transfer Prep
- <u>2019</u>: County Construction (Phase 1) Began

- Pay \$70,000 for Utility Relocation





Fairground Area Property Exchange Summary and Conclusion

This Final Interlocal Agreement:

- Is consistent with prior Council discussion
- Enables the County, City, and District to move forward with public improvements
- Provides partial construction funding for new Challenger and Lake Air Little League facilities, extending their deep legacy, and expanding their capacity to serve Waco's youth
