








Hospitalizations since April



COVID-19 Patient Vaccination Status


- Unvaccinated,hospitalized COVID-19 Patients





Impact of the Delta Variant


- The steep increase is cases can be attributed to the highly contagious Delta variant, which is more than 2x as contagious as previous variants.
- According to Dr. Jennifer Shuford, Chief State Epidemiologist, 99% of COVID-19 cases reported in the state can be attributed to the highly contagious Delta variant.
- Data suggest the Delta variant might cause more severe illness than previous strains in unvaccinated persons
- All the currently available COVID-19 vaccines are effective against the Delta variant.




Fatalities since April







Community based vaccination sites held by the Health District





COVID-19 Vaccination Update

- Weekly HD staff are offering >10 mobile clinics across the county that are open to the public.
- There are daily request for vaccine clinics across the county.
- Several worksites have scheduled reoccurring vaccine clinics for employees.
- COVAX Strike Teams will host clinics in the PTR Monday-Friday, 8:00 am-4:30 pm.
- All 3 COVID-19 vaccine products are readily available in Waco, and throughout McLennan County.

COVID-19 Testing

- DAVACO is providing free test for community members
- PCR Test; self-administered shallow nasal swab
- Results will be provided within 48-72 hours
- All tests will be billed to private or public insurance or billed to CARES funding for uninsured
- Additional testing is being planned
