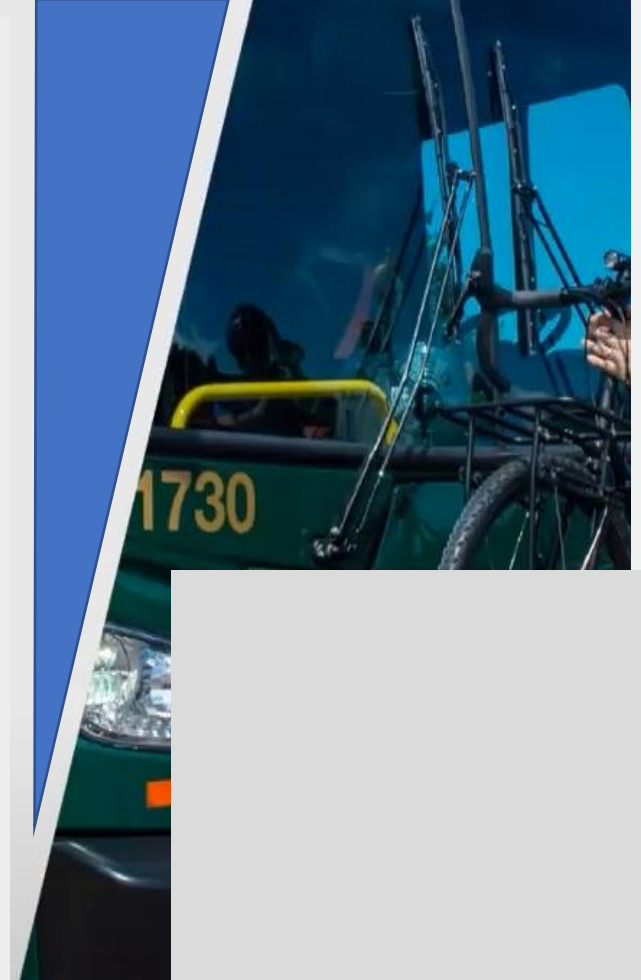

Two-Step Application Process

Step 1

Project Sponsors submit Preliminary Applications (PA)

Preliminary Application (All Projects)

- TxDOT eligibility review
- TxDOT District meeting with eligible project sponsors

Step 2

Project Sponsors submit different Detailed Applications (DA) depending on Funding Opportunity

Community-based

- Standard Detailed Application

Large Scale

- Standard Detailed Application
- Supplemental Narrative

Network Enhancements and Non-Infrastructure

- Modified Detailed Application

Projects Schedule (Tentative)

- June – October 2022 – Get the word out
- October 2022 – Call for Projects opens
- December 2022 – Preliminary Applications due
- April 2023 – Detailed Applications due
- August 2023 – Anticipated Commission award



TxDOT's 2023 TA Call for Projects

- Open to all areas of the state regardless of size
- Up to \$250M to be made available
- Includes large projects, quick-turnaround improvements, and non-infrastructure awards

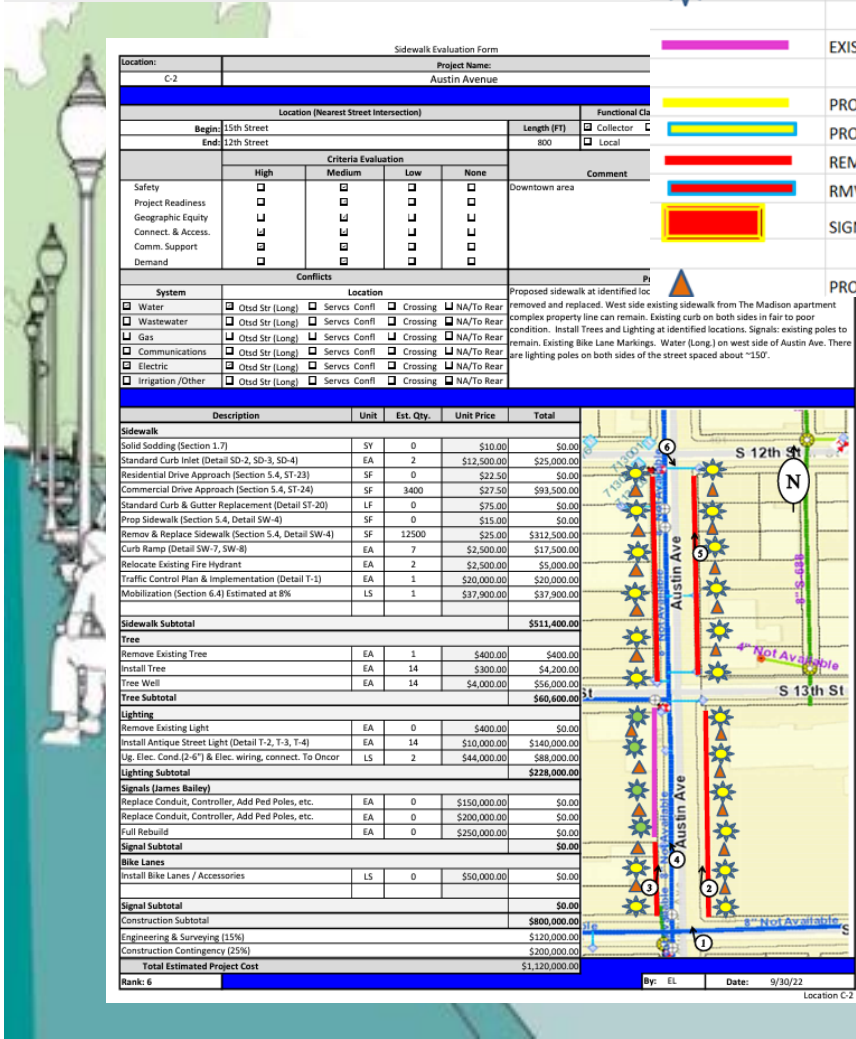
Subject: Sidewalk Options: Technical Memorandum

1.0 Introduction

The City of Waco (City) engaged BGE, Inc. (BGE) to evaluate various sidewalk locations around the city. BGE has been tasked with independently prioritizing the locations, making independent observations and recommendations, and reviewing the preliminary construction cost estimates developed by City staff. This memo documents the analysis methods used and conclusions reached as part our effort to utilize the agreed-to requirements, the considerations involved, and the solutions deemed available to the city. The City intends to move forward with three (3) Transportation Alternative (TA) applications as part of TxDOT’s upcoming Call for Projects in the near-term future.

2.0 History / Data Collection / Survey

The City previously identified (selected) a list of 13 locations to improve the overall condition of the pedestrian friendliness (sidewalks, bike lanes, trees, lighting, and signals) of the locations. Table 1 on the following page provides the listing of the limits of the 13 locations as well as other desired amenity related type items. The City subsequently requested that a 14th location be added: North 15th Street (from Herring to Colcord) to the original list.

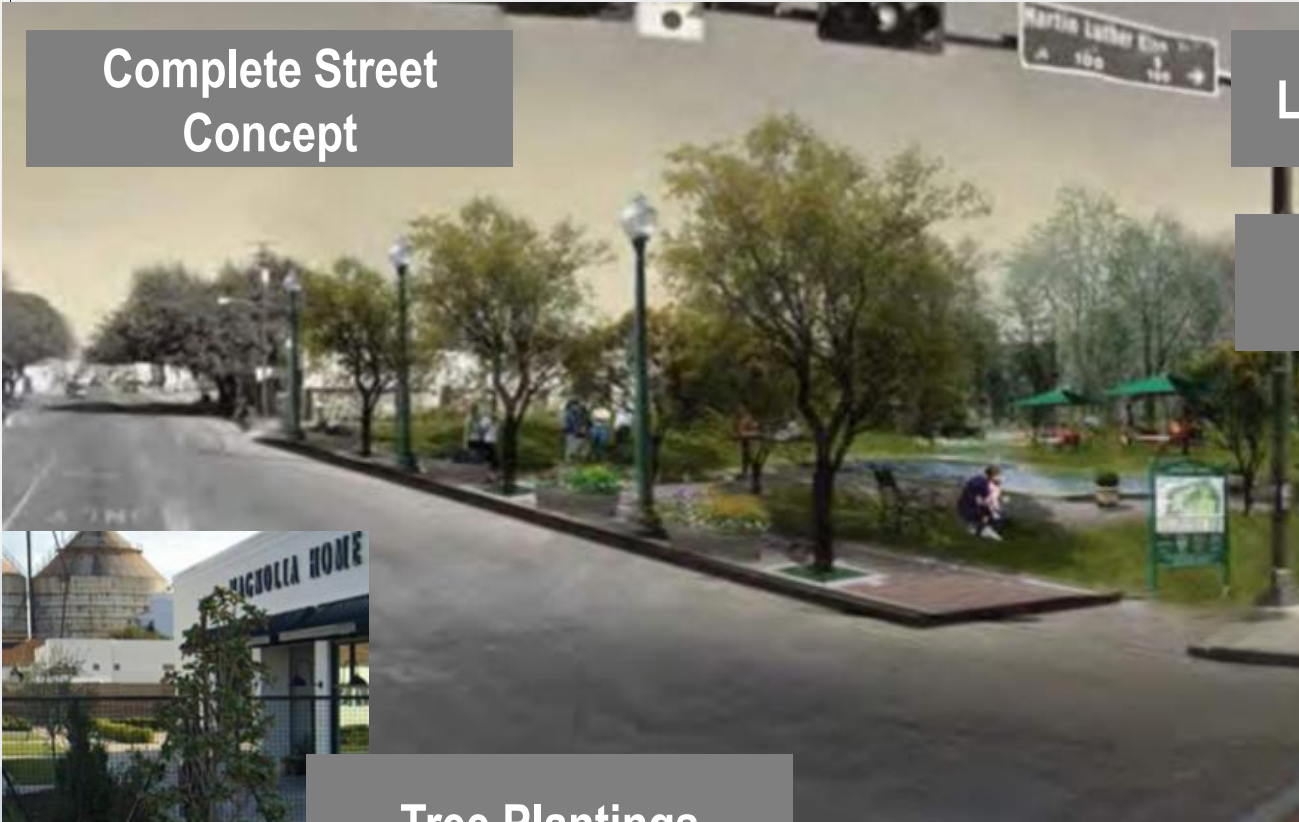
