Legislative Update Calendar and Important Dates

- Monday, November 14, 2022: first day to file bills
- Tuesday, January 10, 2023: start of the 88th Regular Session
- Friday, March 10, 2023: 60-day bill filing deadline
- Monday, May 29, 2023: last day of Regular Session (sine die)

Legislative Update Expectations and Important Bills

- Record breaking revenue estimate for general purpose spending: \$188.23 billion (26% from previous biennium)
- \$32.8 billion budget surplus
- 87th Legislative Session: 8,000 bills filed between both House and Senate
 - Tracked 4,000 bills with potential impacts to cities
