Lost Hispanic Architecture

- Important to Steering Committee to mention "Lost Hispanic Architecture" in Vision Statement
- Hispanic cultural and architectural elements disappeared over time
- Downtown Implementation Plan, Page 23
 - Accentuating character through "specific area branding (signage, wayfinding, banners), public art, or aspirational design."

Area Identity/Use of Streetscape Elements

- Specific area branding for individual sub-area
- Specific streetscape elements show the preferred manufacturers and dimensions of each specific element
- Context-sensitive approach when deciding elements on a case-by-case basis
- At a minimum, be visually similar or in the same manufacturer family

Prioritization Matrix/Order of Priority

- Prioritization Matrix provided on Page 56 of the Plan
- All listed projects are priorities
- Statement provided with Matrix
 - "Priorities could change based on available funding or adjacent catalyst developments, or other location specific opportunities."



Underground Powerlines

- Cost of burying powerlines included in cost estimates
- Plan recommendation to update ordinances, in particular the Downtown Overlay District
 - Private development vs. public development
 - When will it be required
 - Cost burden
 - Use of TIF funding
