Solid Waste Transfer Station

Project Summary

Construct and operate a transfer station to efficiently relocate refuse material from Waco to the MSW 2400 Landfill. The project includes all services surrounding the purchase, permitting, design, and construction of the transfer station and transfer station facilities. It is estimated that the long haul operation facilitated by the transfer station will result in an annual cost savings of approximately \$1,640,000.00 compared to direct hauling waste to the MSW2400 Landfill. The proposed Transfer Station will generate a cost savings for the City of approximately \$20 million over a 10-year period compared to direct hauling.

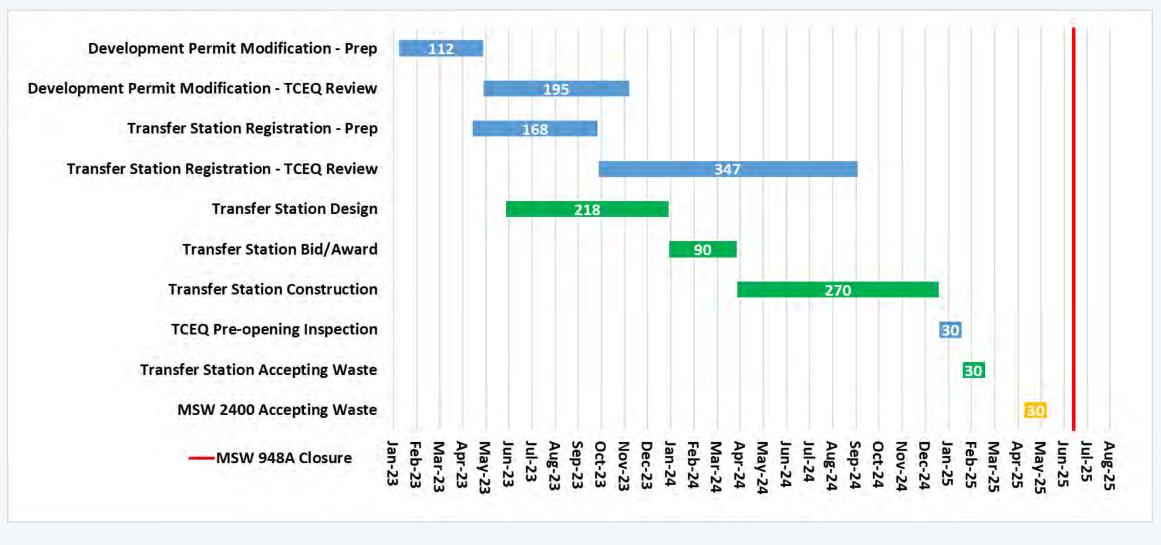

Initial study indicated that Bull Hide Creek WWTP might be able to increase capacity without expanding the plant. Unfortunately the flows at Bull Hide Creek WWTP exceeded the allowance and per State Regulations we are required to expand the plant. Waco City Council approved an ammendment to CDM Smith's contract on March 18, 2023 to proceed with the design to expand Bull Hide Creek WWTP plant from a 1.5 MGD plant to a 4 MGD plant. The City of Hewitt and Lorena will begin paying for their share of the plant in October 2024. Their payments will include their share of the cost for the study, design, and construction of the plant - Lorena 12% and Hewitt 20%. Original Completion was expected Spring 2023.
