What is S.T.E.A.M.?


STEAM is a combination of two or more of the following within a learning experience: **Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Mathematics**.

STEAM also teaches soft skills needed in all careers, such as:

- ✓ Creativity
- ✓ Solving tough problems
- ✓ Critical thinking
- ✓ Gathering and evaluating evidence
- ✓ Making sense of information
- ✓ Data analysis
- ✓ Communication


Benefits of providing Programming

26%

STEM workers tend to earn about 26% more than non-STEM workers.

2x

Yearly growth for STEM jobs is projected to be almost double that of non-STEM jobs.



Whether they work in a STEM field or not, people with a degree in STEM earn more than non-STEM counterparts.

Employers in non-STEM fields heavily recruit graduates with STEM degrees because they possess skills that students with other majors may not have developed.




