• Decision to add art and culture features into the project that were emblematic of Waco

November 2, 2021

 City Council approved contract with Creative Waco to facilitate the public art procurement process

August 2, 2022

• City Council approved two of the four pieces of art

May 16, 2023

• City Council approved the artists and preliminary concepts for the two artworks we'll be discussing today



Waco Regional Airport Recommended Artwork Design – *Welcome Walkway*



Proposed Location – Area Linking Arrival Lounge and Main Concourse

- Showcases the diversity of Waco by integrating repetitions of the phrase "Welcome to Waco"
- Phrases submitted by community members in their language(s) of origin, design created by artist
- Incorporates space's natural light
- Budget: \$12,000
- Dimensions: 50'-7" x 9'-6"

Waco Regional Airport Recommended Art Design – Welcome Walkway *Welcome to Waco,* by Eirini Linardaki



- Removed the tan horizon and replaced with blue sky
- Enlarged the blue sky with text as negative space (printed on transparent wrap) which will appear more subtle
- Varied the size and font of the "Welcome to Waco" phrases in the sky, while retaining the community-submitted artwork on the structures
- Adjusted the scale and placement of the structures so that the ALICO Building is shown as the tallest structure & the courthouse and water tower are not set apart
- Changed the jet silhouette to a CRJ-700, which currently services the airport
- Added an American Sign Language (ASL) interpretation of "Welcome to Waco"




Proposed Location: Main Lobby


- Creates a high-impact and fun artwork that invites social media interactions
- It will be one of the first impressions created on arrival and last moments captured upon departure
- Provides the iconic "I'm in Waco" statement
- Budget: \$25,000
- Artwork Dimensions: 18' x 6'






Recommended Color Palette


- Simplified design centered around one iconic Waco symbol
- Interprets Waco's past, present & future
- Includes both the original brick-faced suspension bridge tower and the current stucco finish
- Longhorn, magnolia and jet illustrate the evolution of the local economy
- River grasses, blue heron show local flora and fauna & call attention to the importance of local waterways
- Suspension cables are emphasized and serve as a unifying element across the design

- Color blocking and shading technique will be utilized
- Reproductions of locally-significant historical documents will be incorporated using a collage effect





AUG 1, 2023: Work-session presenting final design drafts

AUG 15, 2023:Resolution presented to City Council approving
final artwork designs

Final installations will be completed in-step with final phase of construction
