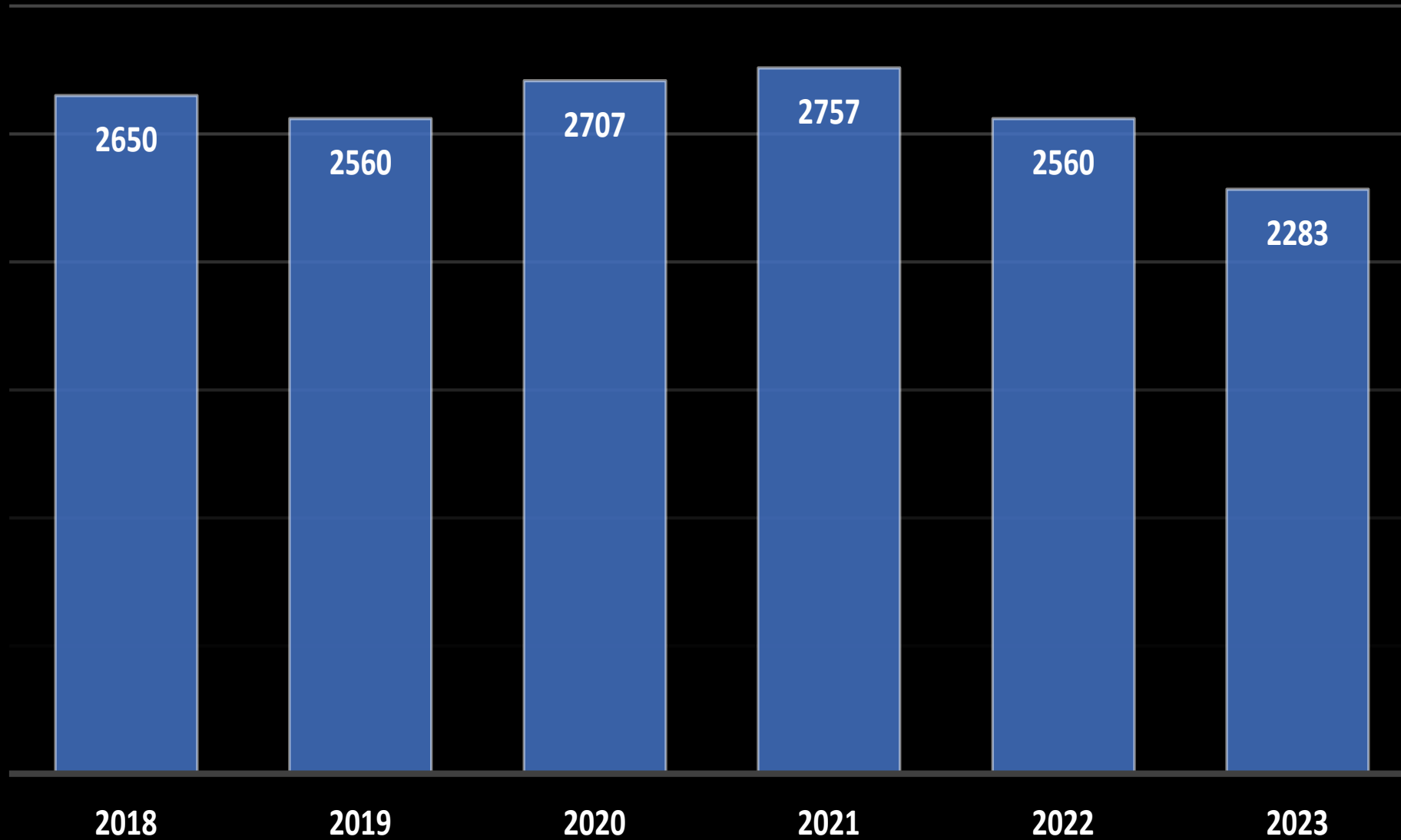

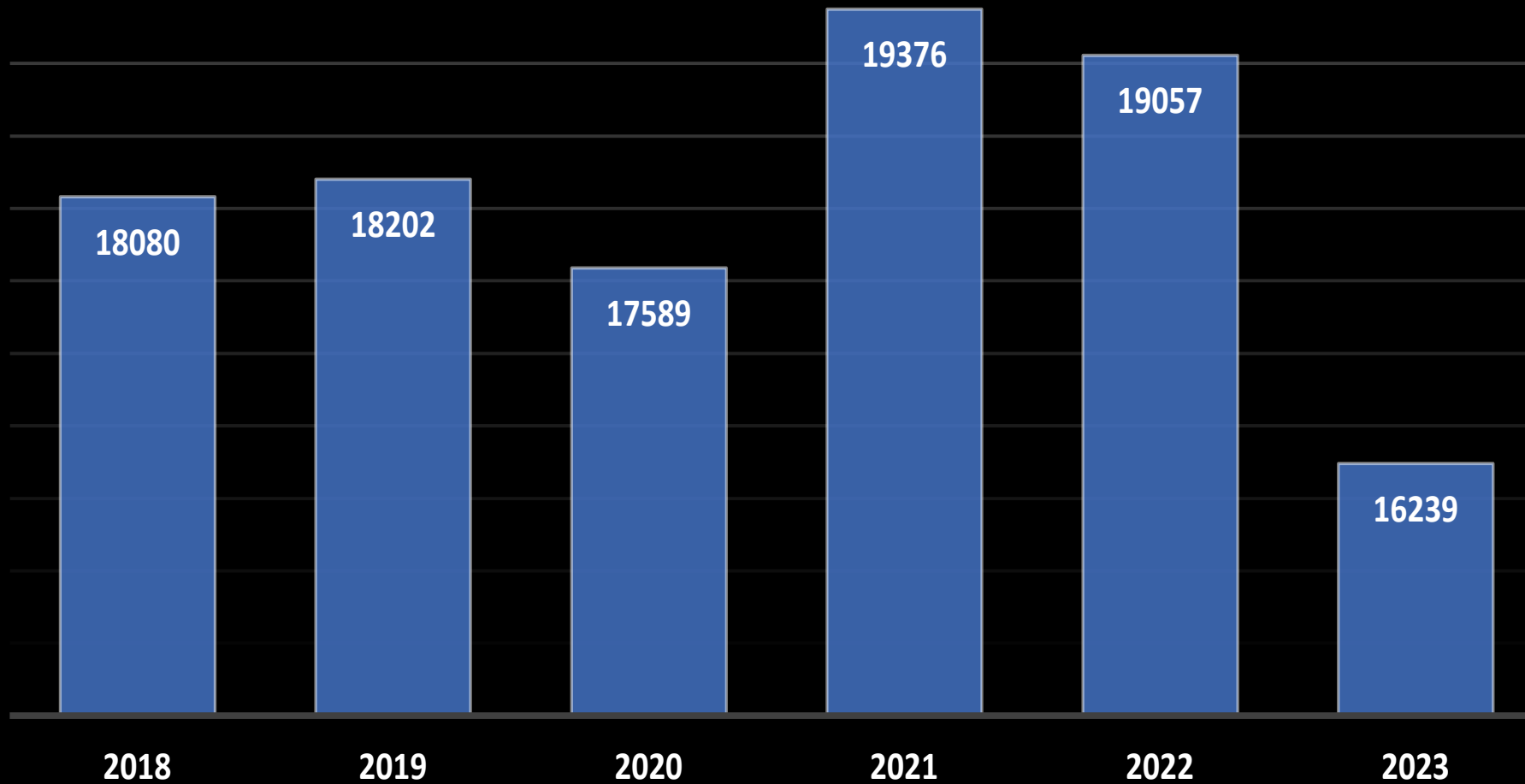

Violent Crime 2018 -2023



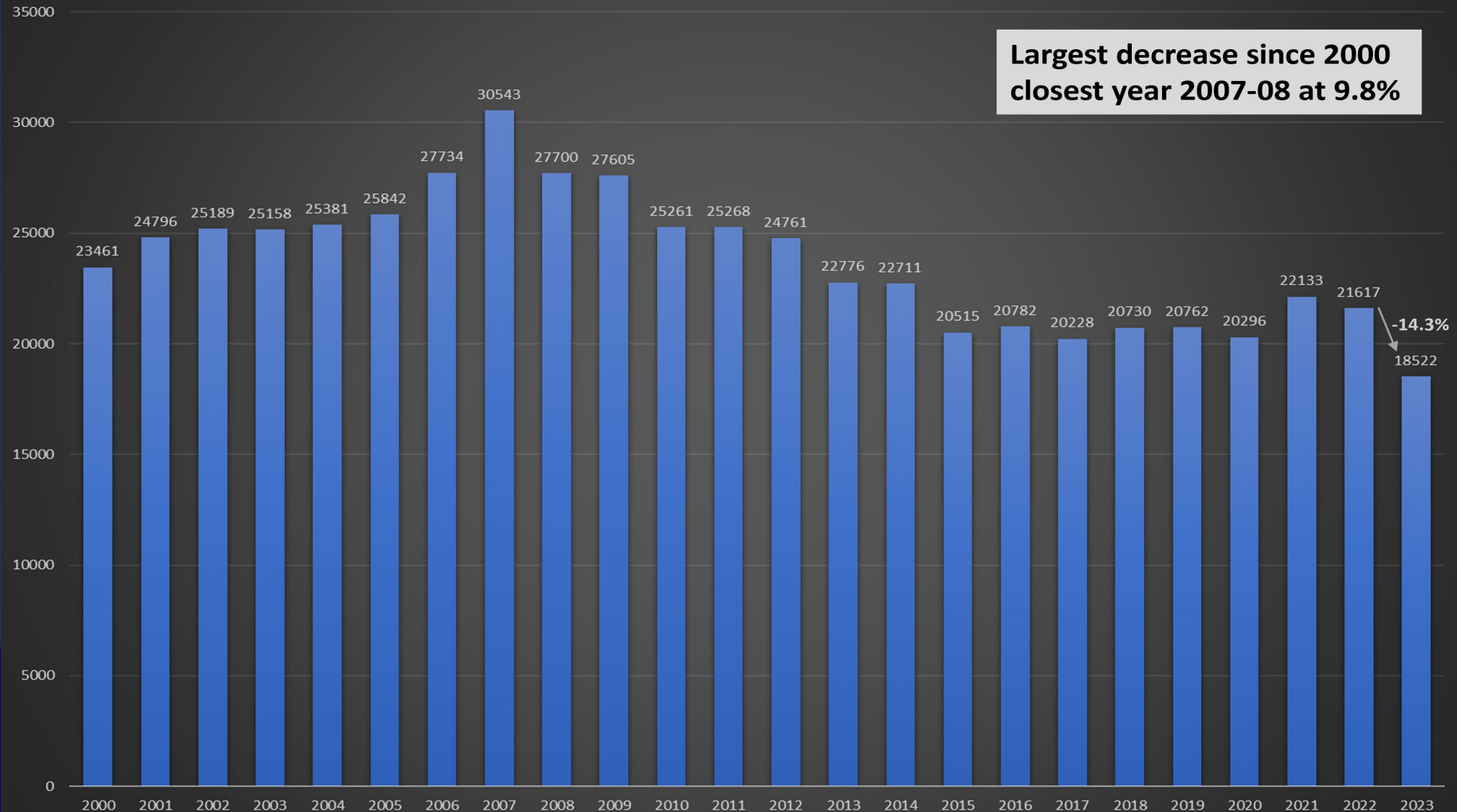
Non-Violent Crime 2018 - 2023

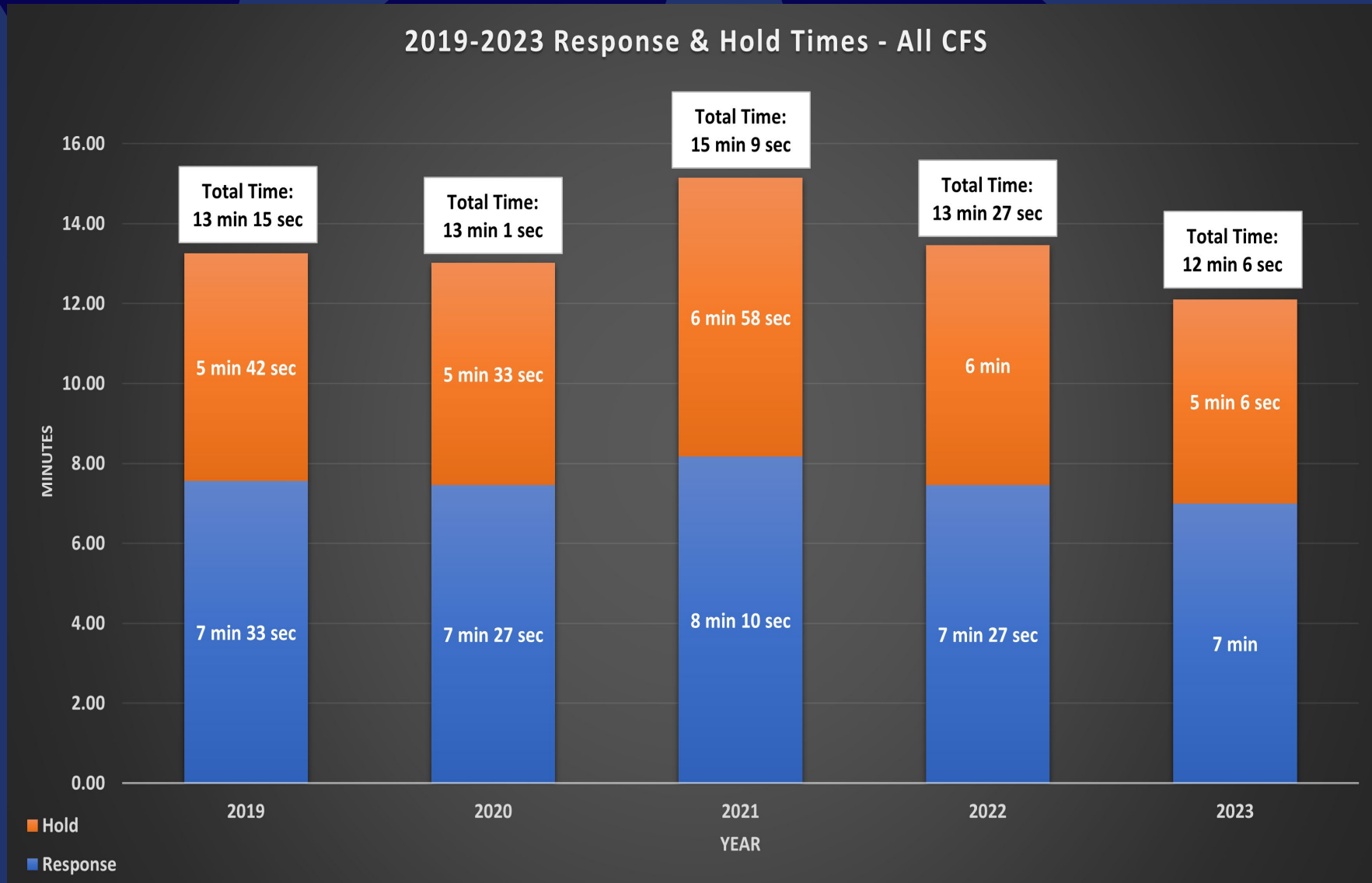

In 2023, we answered 260,609 calls (9-1-1 and non-emergency for Waco and MCSO).



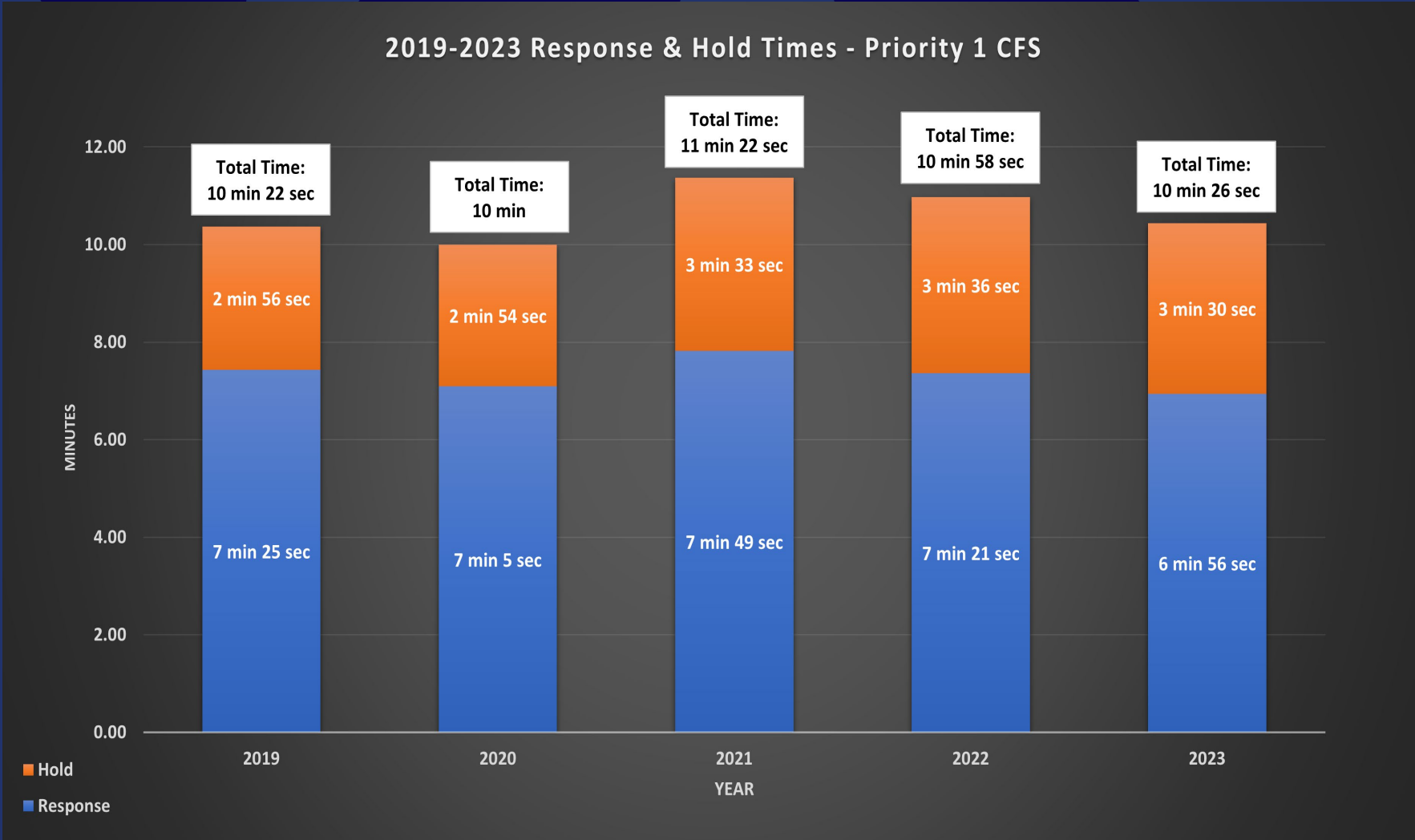
Dispatch Response & Hold Times – All CFS
