Summary of Summer & Fall 2024

- Texas' travel sector outpaced the national average, with hotel demand and air travel showing stronger-than-average growth.
- Leisure and business travel surged, with group demand surpassing 2019 levels and enthusiasm for leisure travel reaching new highs.
- Hotel demand reached record levels, outpacing supply growth and driving strong revenue performance across the state.
- The industry closed out a strong fiscal year, with aggregated lodging metrics and attraction attendance contributing to the momentum.
- Tourism and Travel performance in Winter 2024 and Spring 2025 reflect a different macroeconomic environment and the absence of last year's one-time events, such as the eclipse.















Despite slower start to 2025, Texas is following US lodging demand trends

Leisure hotel booking pace vs same time last year, as of 4/23/2025



Index (2019 = 100)






US lodging demand nights per capita







March, 2025 Passenger Throughput by State


All passengers (domestic + international), % change vs. 2019




Group room nights drawing closer to 2019 levels





Supply Growth continues to Outpace Demand




Growth in Supply is showing pressure on rates









Aggregated hotel & shortterm rental lodging demand is up +3.3% Year to date.


Short term rentals are down -14.4%, while hotel demand is ahead by +5.4% Year to date.
















Hotel Occupancy Tax Collections

April 2025 vs. comparable months over the past 5 years









American Airlines Passenger Enplanements






General Aviation Activity
