


Project Background

- Alice Martinez Rodriguez Park will transform 30 acres of open space into an inclusive, regional park.
- Celebrating the area's cultural heritage, the park will feature a variety of natural spaces and recreational amenities to create a sense of vibrancy and serve the community's diverse needs.
- The project represents Waco's largest investment in a public park, which will be home to Waco's first all-inclusive playground.



A Destination Park for All



- Centrally located and easily accessible, Alice Martinez Rodriguez Park will serve as a community and regional destination

 - Indian Spring Park

 - Waco Mammoth National Monument


Project Background

Purpose: Create an inclusive park along Clay Avenue and adjacent to the former site of Floyd Casey Stadium

- 2022 Master Development Agreement for development of stadium site
- 2022-2023 Council allocation of \$25.34 million for park design and construction
- 2023 2025 Community Input, Vision Plan, Design Documents, Construction Documents, Proposal Packets and Strategies

- June 23: Requests for Proposals and Bid Documents Released
- July 15: Pre-Bid Meeting Onsite with Prospective Contractors
- July 31: Proposal Opening
- August 1: Bid Scoring
- August 6: Contractor Interview
- August 7-14: Contract Execution
- September: Groundbreaking and Construction
- End of 2026: Park Opening

Base Bid and Alternate Overview:

- Base bid included infrastructure, interpretative areas, and core park amenities such as playground, trails, plaza, pavilion and bridge
- Alternates included sports courts (1), great lawn (4), all wheels park (5), playground procurement deduction (6)
- Alternates for Track and Field (2, 3) are not included in totals. A scope reserve of \$2.2M remains in the overall budget for Track and Field.

Evaluation Process and Criteria:

• Scored on five categories included pricing, duration, project experience project manager experience and company reputation


