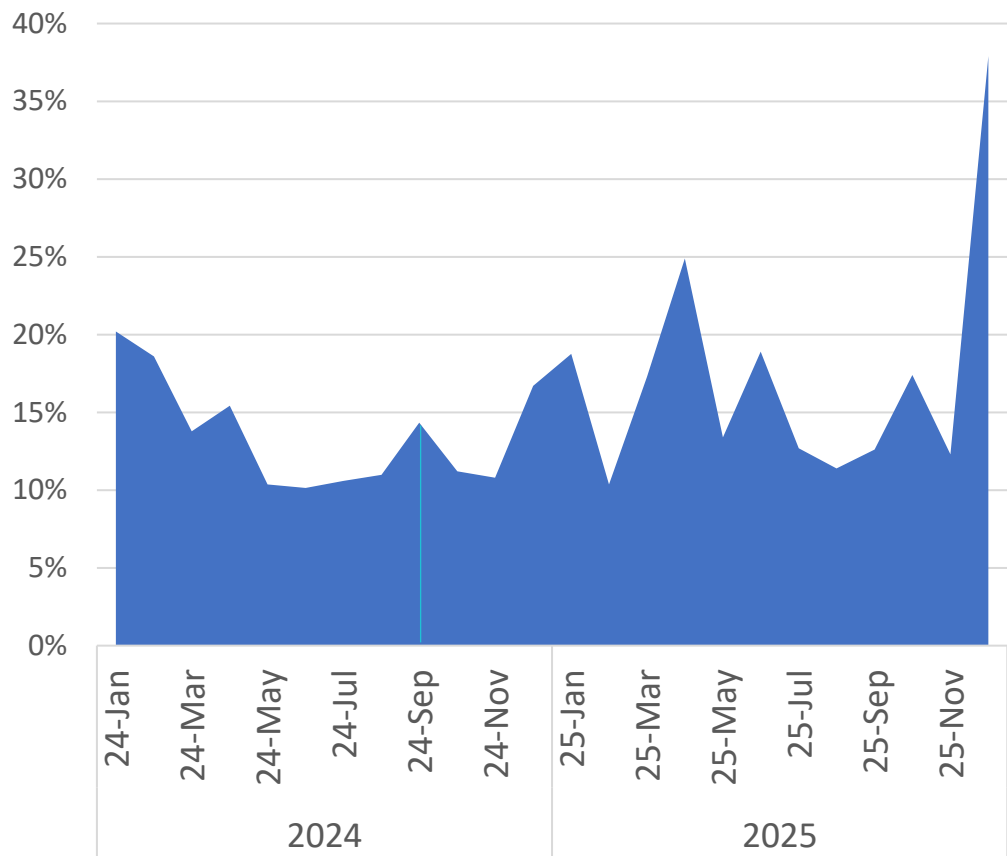
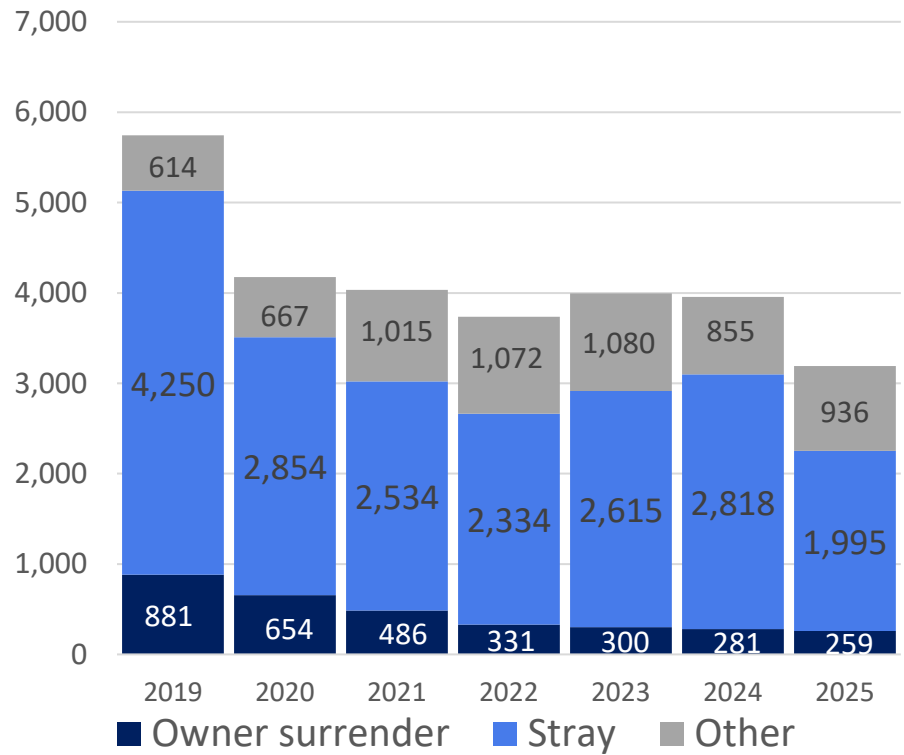

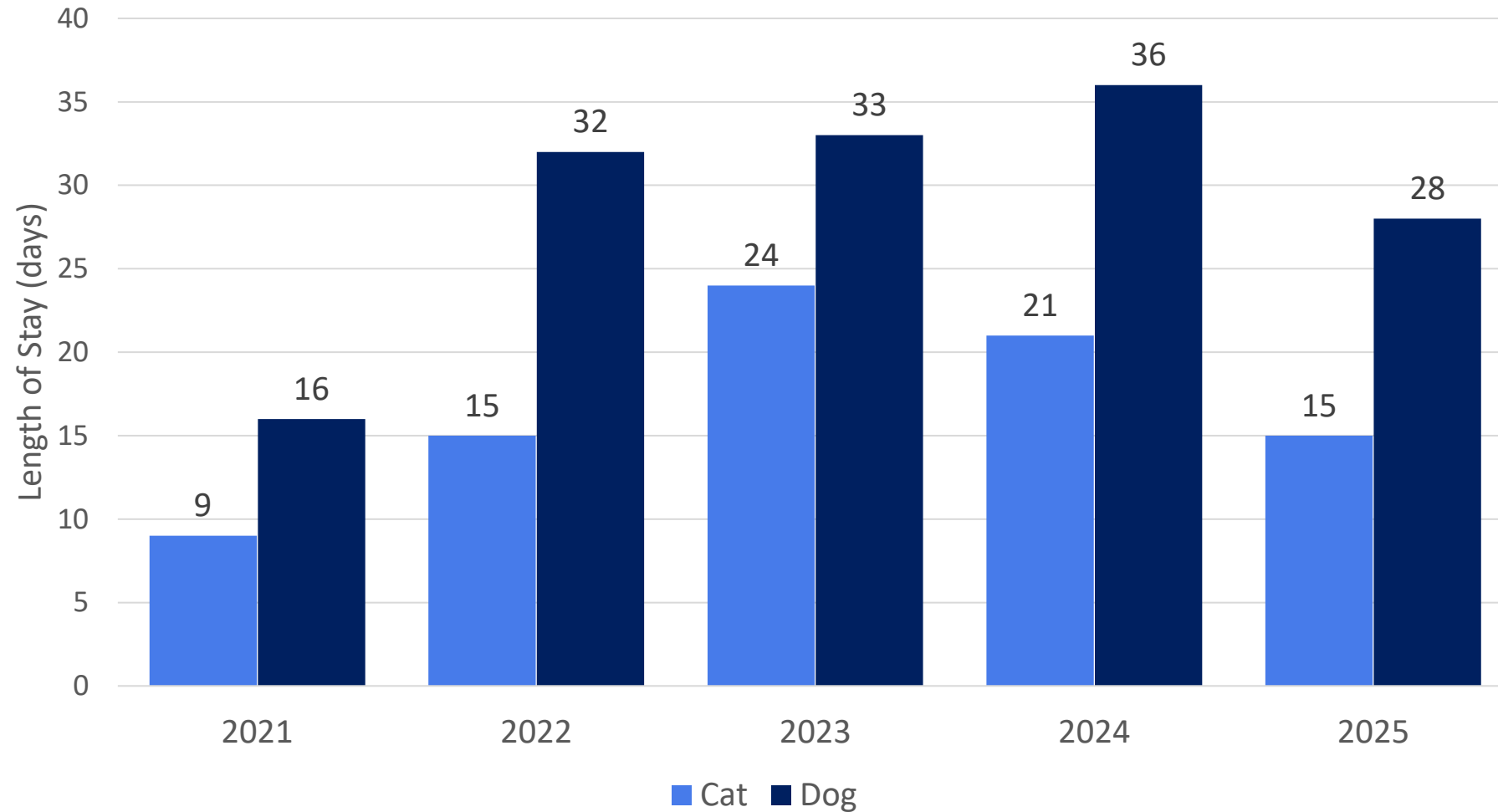

Animal Intakes and Return to Owner (RTO) Rates

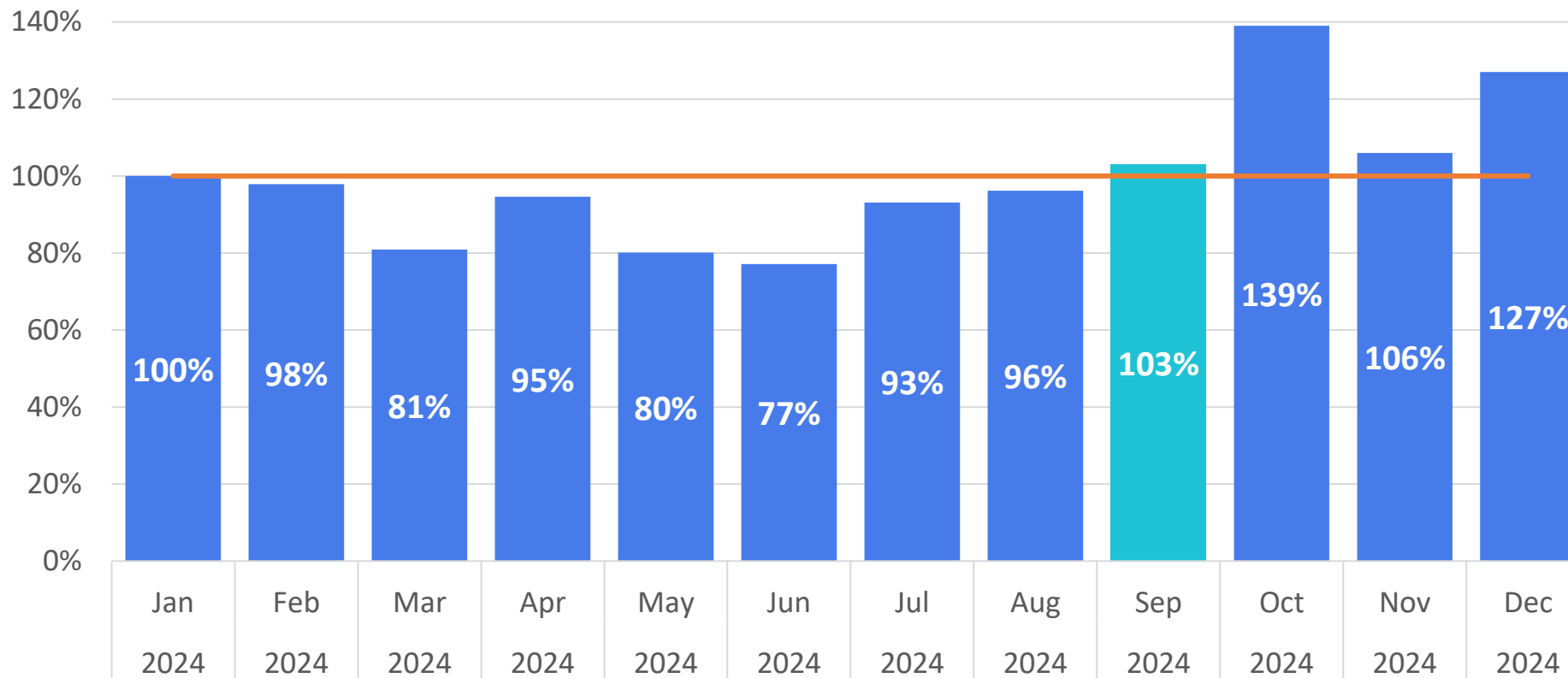


Average Length of Stay (days) before adoption



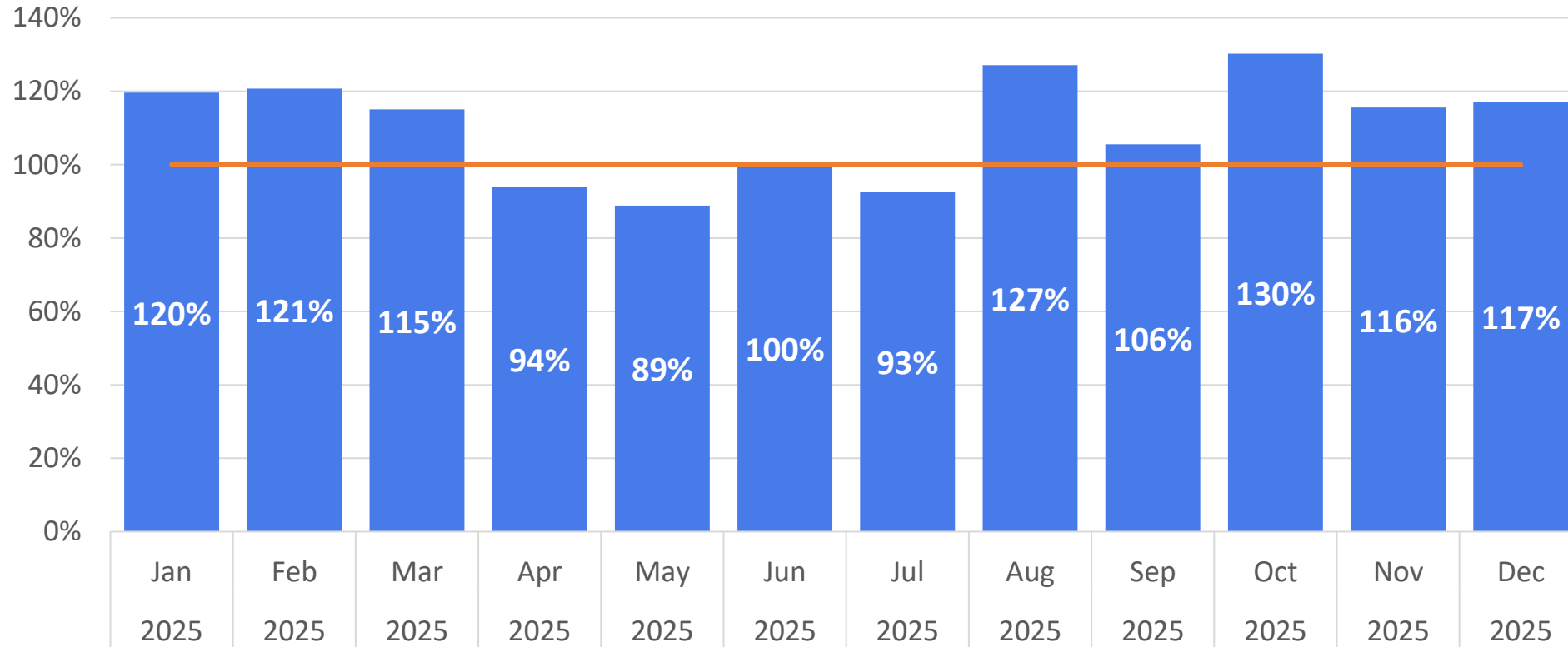
2024 SAC Population Balance Calculator

- Under 100% means animals stayed in the shelter system

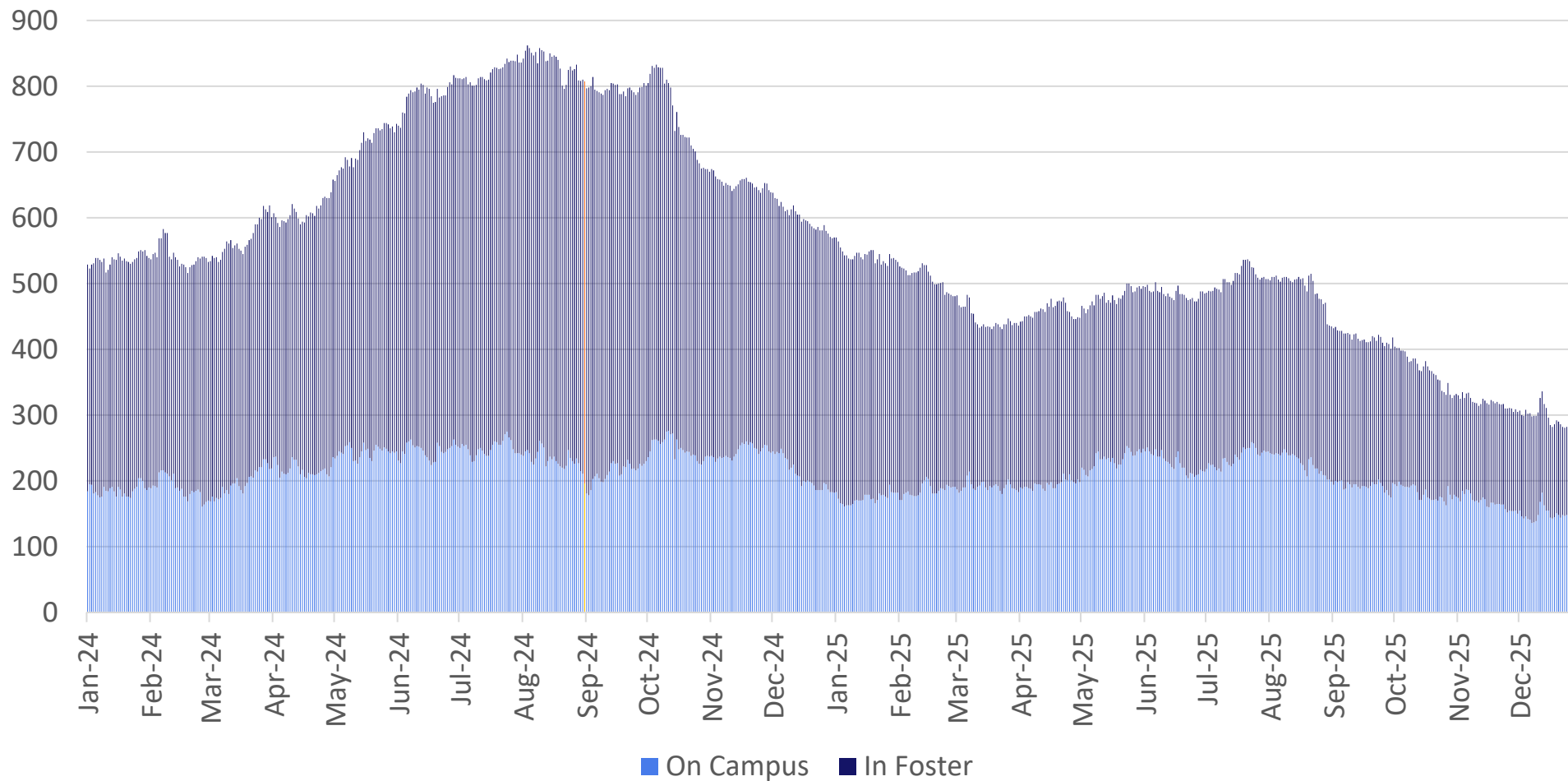


2025 SAC Population Balance Calculator

- Under 100% means animals stayed in the shelter system

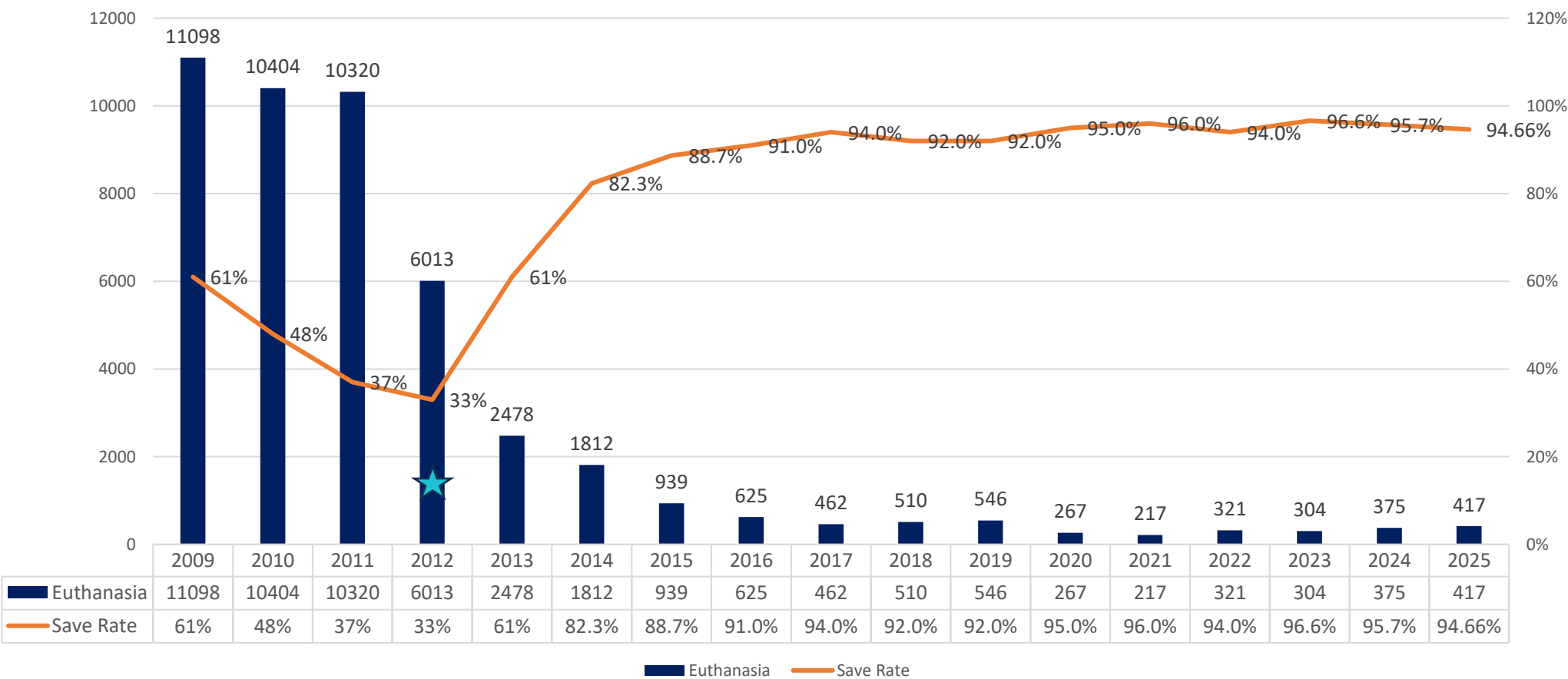


Total Animals in Care



Euthanasia and Save Rate: 2009-2025

• 90% or more live-exit rate achieved and maintained since 2016



ADDITIONAL ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- Animals Born in shelter care have decreased by 74%
- Adoption returns have decreased by 20%
- Spay/Neuter numbers increased by 117 animals
- Community and national partnerships strengthened
 - Spay/neuter community services in shelter have increased 99% from last year

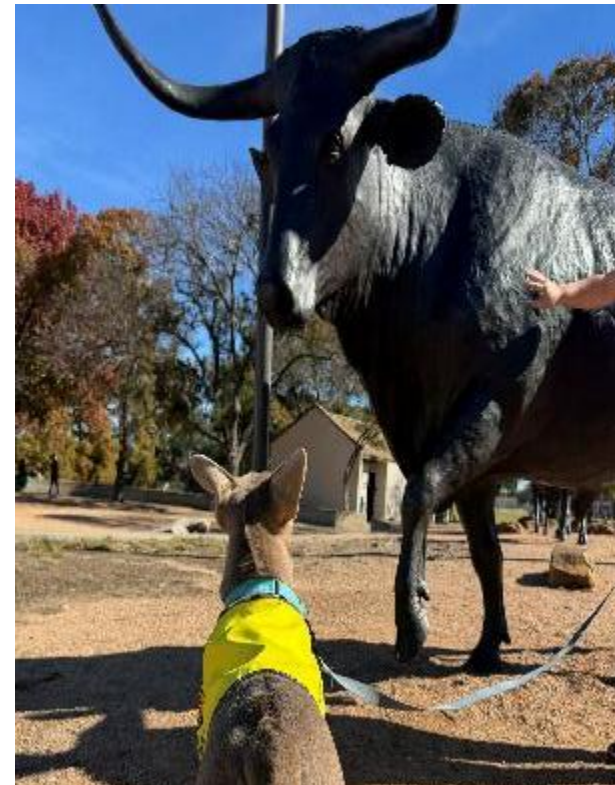

OPERATIONAL UPDATES

SHELTER RE-ASSESSMENT AND INTAKE CHANGES

- Shelter Re-Assessment
 - Team Shelter USA came back to the shelter in August 2025 to evaluate programs since the transition and provide guidance to staff.
 - Noted the shelter was operating above capacity still, and recommended suspending owner surrender appointments.
- Bellmead exited Shelter contract September 2025
 - September 1st Bellmead intakes were no longer accepted into the shelter.



CHALLENGES AND OPPORTUNITIES

- Growing pressure on Animal Protection Officers
 - Large increase in call volume and demands for service

City	Population	ACO #s	Call #s
San Antonio	1,500,000	55	89,000
Austin	989,000	15	26,229
Waco	148,000	7	21,616
Amarillo	204,000	16	17,000

- No protection as First Responders
 - Can make retention harder
- Constant turnover with a long training process
- Public confusion about role or duties
- National Animal Care and Control Association consultation scheduled for February 2026 to do a program evaluation and process improvement workshop
