City of Waco Offices Remain Closed Tomorrow Warming Center Hours Extended

WACO, TEXAS (January 31, 2023) – City of Waco non-essential services will remain closed tomorrow, February 1, due to inclement weather. Solid Waste collection and landfill operations have been suspended, and operations will resume on Thursday, February 2. Place collection carts out on your normal day and leave them out until collected. Collection operations will begin with the remaining Tuesday routes and will continue collection through Saturday. Landfill operations will open as normal on Thursday. Other city essential services will still run as usual.

The City of Waco and Waco-McLennan County Office of Emergency Management will continue to operate the warming center at Dewey Community Center (925 N 9th Street) until 8:00 am on Thursday, February 2. Cots, blankets, snacks, and bottled water are available. Pets are accepted as long as they are in a crate.
