Holiday Cheer Fire Engine

The Waco Fire Department's Holiday Cheer Fire Engine is kicking off the holiday fun the day after Thanksgiving and going through Friday, December 22. Changes this year include scheduled stops every night for residents to take photos and meet the firefighters.

Each scheduled night, the engine will begin their route at 5:30 p.m., driving 10 mph through certain streets marked on the route map. Route maps are available online. At approximately 8 p.m., the engine will stop at a location central to the neighborhood for residents to take photos. Most neighborhoods will be covered twice, and the roads not covered the first time will be covered on the second date.
