Warmer temperatures mean pool season is here! Now is the perfect time for you to inspect your pools and spas to ensure they are in compliance. Please review the federal, state and local requirements for pools and spas.

To prevent dangerous conditions and violations, at least one person should inspect your pools and spas regularly. In addition to water chemistry, review the items below when inspecting your pools and spas.

DRAIN COVERS



CHECK DRAIN COVERS TO ENSURE:

- They are being replaced as specified by the manufacturer
- They are not lost, broken, or have missing screws

CIRCULATION SYSTEM



EXAMINE THE CIRCULATION SYSTEM AND REPAIR ANY DEFICIENCIES ON THE:

- Filters
- Pressure Gages
- Safety Vacuum Release Systems (Test Vac Alerts)
- Flow Meters
- Pumps

SAFETY EQUIPMENT



ENSURE SAFETY EQUIPMENT IS ACCESSIBLE & IN GOOD CONDITION, WHICH INCLUDES:

- Shepherd's Hook
- Buoy/Life Ring with attached rope
- Emergency Telephones
- Spa Emergency Shut Off System

POOL SIGNAGE



REVIEW ALL POOL SIGNAGE TO MAKE SURE THE SIGNS ARE:

- Legible
- Not faded
- Not cracked/chipped
