



RESOLUTION 2023-12

WHEREAS the Waco Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) was established to identify and support the implementation of regionally significant transportation projects to address future mobility needs of the Waco Region;

WHEREAS the Waco MPO Policy Board is composed of representatives appointed by the elected City Councils and Counties located within the jurisdiction of the MPO as well as the Texas Department of Transportation;

WHEREAS the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA) established the Carbon Reduction Program (CRP) in November of 2021 to provide \$6.4 billion in funds over five years to reduce transportation emissions from on-road highways sources;

WHEREAS The Waco MPO is expected to receive a suballocation of CRP funds of approximately \$2.2 million in FY 2023;

WHEREAS the Waco MPO Policy Board has the opportunity to create, design, and implement a Carbon Reduction Program for its planning area subject to federal and state requirements; and,

WHEREAS The Waco MPO's Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) is recommending the MPO Policy Board to adopt Projects recommended by the Technical Advisory Committee and Bike + Ped Workgroup for the Carbon Reduction Program Call for Proposals;

Now, therefore, be it **RESOLVED**, that the Waco MPO Policy Board

1. Adopts the following projects recommended by the Technical Advisory Committee and Bike + Ped Workgroup for the Carbon Reduction Program Call for Proposals;


