RAISE Grant

Rebuilding American Infrastructure with Sustainability and Equity




•Rebuilding American Infrastructure with Sustainability and Equity (RAISE) grant established by the BIL

- \$1.5 billion in appropriated funds available in FY 2023
- Focused on safety, environmental sustainability, quality of life, mobility and community connectivity, economic competitiveness, equity, and innovation
- Waco MPO submitted grant proposal February 2023
 - Smart Corridor Plan
 - Consideration of appropriate interventions along 9-mile corridor

•Awarded \$4.8 million grant for smart corridor planning– *June 2023*





Waco Metropolitan Planning Organization

- Plan, design, and engineer a comprehensive mobility space utilizing smart network
- Maximize access/opportunities for interaction
- Promote equitable and just outcomes
- •Scalable in physical and technological scope
- Ensure system-wide gains in climate benefits, disaster preparedness and resiliency

- Investigate and design decentralized decision-making processes for a mobility space that integrates disparate systems of:
 - Transportation networks (freight and private)
 - Public spaces
 - Buildings
 - Emergency operations
 - Commerce

Carbon Reduction Program

Waco MPO's 2023 Carbon Reduction Program Call for Proposals

- Proposal Evaluation Committee Recommendations to TAC
- Award \$1,356,000 federal funds for 5 proposals submitted by local project sponsors
 - \$434,785 total local match
 - \$1,790,811 total estimated costs
- Award up to \$1,058,160 federal funds to advance sections of 3 projects from the MPO Active Transportation Plan (ATP)*
 - Design & engineering underway
- *Note: Flexible strategy to address ~\$2.2M estimated available funding







Purpose and Need for MTP Amendment

Proposed Amendment 4

- Reflect Texas Transportation Commission
 priority
 - Construction of IH-35 4C
- Reflect new funding
 - Carbon Reduction Program (CRP)
 - FTA Low/No Emission Vehicle Program
- Reflect refinements to planned projects
 - TxDOT requested revisions identified during the engineering design phase of projects





Proposed MTP Amendment IH-35 C Construction

•Texas Transportation Commission Priority

- Construction of IH-35 4C
 - Identified in TxDOT's 2023 Unified Transportation Program (UTP)
 - Adopted by TTC August 16, 2023
 - TxDOT's Financial Management Division estimates revenue will be available to TxDOT to begin construction in 2024





Proposed MTP Amendment IH-35 C Construction

Reflect Waco MPO Commitment

- Reprioritize IH-35 4C from long term priority to highest short- term priority
 - Action: Revise short-term and long-term priorities in Strategy 5 (Address Demand for Future Mobility) to reflect new prioritization
 - Action: Align estimated project implementation costs with those identified in 2023 UTP
 - Revise scope of work, estimated cost
 - Increase in project cost from \$250M to \$275M
 - Adds ~\$275M in short term priorities and removes \$250M in long term priorities





Proposed MTP Amendment Carbon Reduction Strategies

•Waco MPO Carbon Reduction Program (CRP)

- Waco MPO 2023 Call for Proposals
 - Awards \$2.1 million in federal CRP funds to entities within the Waco MPO planning area to implement projects intended to reduce carbon emissions
 - Action: Revise short-term priorities in Strategy 4 (Improve Regional Livability) to add \$2.1M of FY 2024 CRP funds allocated to Waco MPO and \$699,326 of required nonfederal local match to fund project implementation
 - Adds ~\$2.8M in short term priorities





Proposed MTP Amendment Green House Gas Emissions Reduction Strategy

- Transit Low or No Emission Grant Award (2023)
 - Competitive federal funds for acquiring zero- and/or low- emission transit vehicles
 - Waco Transit received grant to purchase 4 batteryelectric vehicles & chargers
 - Action: Revise short-term priorities in Strategy 6 (Provide Equal Access and Benefits) to add \$3.1 million of federal 5339(c) funds awarded to Waco Transit and \$546,000 of required non-federal local match for this purchase
 - Adds ~\$3.7M in short term priorities





•Align revised scopes of work, project limits and project costs with those identified within the engineering design phase per TxDOT Waco District

- Action: Revise short-term priorities in Strategy 2 (Improve Safety and Security)
 - US 84 (Hewitt Dr to SH 6)
 - US 84 (Spur 298 to Lake Air Dr)
- Action: Revise short-term priorities in Strategy 5 (Address Demand for Future Mobility)
 - Spur 298 (Franklin at New Rd)
 - SH 31 (at FM 2311/Heritage Pkwy)





- Revisions to Strategy 2 (Improve Safety and Security)
 - US 84 (Woodway)
 - FM 1695 (Hewitt Dr) to Spur 298
 - Revise extent, scope of work, estimated cost
 - Increase in project cost from \$72M to \$179M
 - Adds ~\$107M in short term priorities
 - US 84 (Franklin Ave) new ramp project
 - Spur 298 to Lake Air Dr
 - Add all project details including extent, scope of work, estimated costs
 - \$8M estimated cost
 - Adds \$8M in short term priorities





•Revisions to Strategy 2 (Improve Safety and Security)

- SH 31 (at FM2311/Heritage Pkwy)
 - Revise extent, scope of work, estimated cost
 - Increase in overall project cost from \$10M to \$12.2M
 - Adds \$2M in short term priorities





- Revisions to Strategy 5 (Address Demand for Future Mobility)
 - Spur 298 (Franklin Ave)
 - US 84 to SL 396 (Valley Mills Dr)
 - Revise extent, scope of work, estimated cost
 - Increase in overall project cost from \$38M to \$40M
 - Adds \$2M in short term priorities





Proposed MTP Amendment Financial Analysis

- Total Cost of Amendment
 - \$46.2M
 - Amendment increases short term priorities by \$296.2M
 - Amendment decreases long term priorities by \$250M



 Total Cost of Long Range Plan Recommendations after Amendment

- \$2,237.3M
 - Previous MTP Cost = \$2,191.1M (increase of \$46.2M)



Purpose and Need for TIP Amendment

•Proposed Amendment 1

- Consistency with 2045 MTP
- Program funding identified for federal highway, public transportation, and pedestrian projects within the Waco region
 - IH-35 4C construction
 - SH 31 & Spur 298 construction
 - Transit vehicle purchase FTA 5339(c) grant funds
 - Carbon reduction strategies (Appendix F revisions)
 - Design revisions to highway projects
- FAST Act Requirements
 - Update performance targets (Appendix G revisions)





Statewide Priority Allocation

- Texas Transportation Commission Priority:
 - Construction of IH-35 4C
- Action: Program identified funds for IH-35 4C into FY 2023-2026 TIP as requested by TxDOT Waco District
 - Revisions highlighted in Section 1.2 of Amendment 1 and Highway Financial Summary





- Program federal & state funds awarded through supplementary programs
 - Action: Program funds awarded to Waco Transit through the Low or No Emission Program (competitive grant)
 - Revisions highlighted in Section 1.3, transit project descriptions, and transit financial summary of Amendment 1
 - Action: Program funds awarded to local entities by Waco MPO through the Carbon Reduction Program (formula grant)
 - CRP awarded projects are "grouped" to provide an efficient method of programming and letting projects and to decrease the necessity for TIP/STIP revisions
 - Revisions highlighted in Section 1.4 and Appendix F of Amendment 1





- Program Project Adjustments
 - Necessitated by design and engineering process
 - Requested by TxDOT Waco District
 - Regional projects currently programmed for engineering, right-of-way acquisition and/or construction phases
 - Revisions highlighted in Section 1.2 and highway financial summary of Amendment 1
 - Regional projects currently undergoing environmental assessment
 - Revisions highlighted in Appendix D of Amendment 1





- Action: Program adjustments to project limits, scope of work and/or project costs for projects included in engineering phase and/or right-of-way acquisition and in Appendix D
 - US 84 (Hewitt Dr to Spur 298) engineering & row phases
 - US 84 (Spur 298 to Lake Air Dr) engineering phase





Proposed TIP Amendment

- Performance Targets
 - The progress of implemented mobility strategies are measured against performance targets to assess strengths and weaknesses
 - Periodically, targets may be adjusted to improve performance and expected impact
- Action: Update Appendix G to reflect revised performance targets and how new programming will assist in achieving targets
 - Includes revisions to targets supported by the Waco MPO Policy Board over the past year
 - Accordance with FAST Act requirements
 - Revisions highlighted in Section 1.5 and Appendix G of Amendment 1

Unified Planning Work Program Proposed Amendment to FY 2022 – 2023 Work Plan & Budget



What is the Unified Planning Work Program?

•UPWP serves as the MPO's work plan and operating budget

- Currently operating under FY 2022-2023 UPWP
- Identifies how federal highway and transit planning funds are intended to be used
 - Estimates amount of federal planning funds available
- Identifies each task MPO intends to accomplish and total funds to be used



Proposed UPWP Amendment

Amend Task 5 – Special Studies

- Add subtask 5.2 to carry out a Low/Zero Emission Propulsion Study, Infrastructure Assessment, and Transition Plan
- Requested by Waco Transit System
- 1-year additional cost (FY 2023): \$86,348
 - \$64,761 federal funds
 - \$21,587 local funds

ROADWAY: US 84 COST: \$9,930,693.78 LIMITS: Centerpoint Dr to FM 933 SCOPE: Install sidewalk and upgrade signals TIMELINE: Est. Completion Fall 2023

-All signals active. Currently awaiting final TDLR inspection, punchlist, and final completion.

Spring Valley Widening

ROADWAY: FM 2113 COST: \$15,387,558.27 LIMITS: From Sun Valley to Hewitt Dr SCOPE: Adding Turn Lane, Shoulders, and Drainage TIMELINE: Anticipate Fall 2024 Completion

- Continuing permanent pavement construction on east side of roadway between Sun Valley and Old Temple.

- Continuing permanent drainage construction between Old Temple and Hewitt Dr.
- -Anticipate opening east half of new roadway late this fall.

Current Projects

SH 6 at Baylor Camp

ROADWAY: SH 6 COST: \$723,086.00 LIMITS: SH 6 at Baylor Camp Rd SCOPE: Adding Turn Lane TIMELINE: Fall 2023 Completion

- Completed widening of drainage structure and started shoulder widening.

- Will begin paving after Labor Day.

Current Projects

SH 6 Mall to Mall

ROADWAY: SH 6 COST: \$54,894,543.25 LIMITS: Bagby Ave to US 84 SCOPE: Widen freeway, construct frontage road bridges, and reconfigure ramps TIMELINE: Est. Completion Early 2024

- All 4 new frontage road bridges open to traffic
- Anticipate moving mainlan traffic to new bridges closest to US 84 after Labor Day.
- Continuing construction of new mainlane pavement and bridges between Bagby and Imperial Dr.





ROADWAY: IH 35 COST: \$6,126,287.10 LIMITS: N. Loop 340 to BU 77 SCOPE: Mill and Inlay TIMELINE: Est. Completion End of 2023

- Milling existing surface in northbound direction. Expect to begin paving after Labor Day.

- Will begin milling southbound when northbound paving starts.
- -Paving expected to be complete by end of October.


