Categories:

Sustained Excellence – for structures/sites maintained, but never restored. Sustained Excellence awards may be awarded to any Educational Programs, Historic sites, Public/Government Buildings, Institutional Buildings, Residences, or Commercial Buildings.

Excellence in Restoration – for structures/sites restored to maintain historical significance. Excellence in Restoration awards may be awarded to any Educational Programs, Historic sites, Public/Government Buildings, Institutional Buildings, Residences, or Commercial Buildings.

Excellence in Education – awarded to individuals and organizations that have demonstrated an exceptional commitment to disseminating Waco's history for the benefit of posterity.

Leadership in Historic Preservation – awarded to individuals and organizations that have demonstrated an exceptional commitment to historic preservation in Waco.

Classifications

Educational Programs

Historic Sites – a *site* is defined as the location of a significant event, a pre-historic or historic occupation or activity, or a building or structure, whether standing, ruined, or vanished, where the location itself possesses historical, cultural, or archeological value regardless of the value of any existing structure

Public (Government) Buildings

Structures – a structure is defined as a functional construction, other than a building, made usually for purposes other than creating human shelter, such as a bridge, a silo, a kiln, a fence, an earthwork, or any other such construction.

Institutional Buildings (churches, schools, colleges, and universities)

Commercial Buildings (apartments, businesses)

Residential (houses)

Individuals or Organizations (persons or groups who have shown outstanding leadership in historic preservation efforts)
