## **Glossary of Common Terms**

**ASSAULT-** a person commits assault if the person causes bodily injury to another person or threatens to cause imminent bodily injury. Assaults can range from simple assault which usually results in a citation to aggravated assault, which depending on the circumstances can be a 1<sup>st</sup> degree felony.



**BURGLARY-** a person commits a burglary if, without the owners permission, the person enters a residence, building or vehicle with the intent to commit theft.

**CRIMINAL MISCHIEF-** commonly referred to as Vandalism, a person commits criminal mischief if he damages or destroys property of another person.

**ROBBERY-** a person commits robbery if during a theft he causes injury or the threat of injury to the victim of the theft.
