Submitted Questions:

Q. In Section V. Statement of Qualifications (SOQ), Paragraph E No Price Information states SOQs containing any price information will be automatically disqualified but Section VI. Evaluation of Submittals & Award of Contract, Paragraph C Evaluation Criteria lists Cost of Service including all equipment, materials, and overhead necessary to perform work under the condition of this solicitation.

Is pricing to be included or excluded from the submittal?

If pricing is to be excluded, how is the “Importance” of the Cost of Services and Timeliness (Including Response Times) effected?

A. Yes, pricing should be included in the response.

Q. The Scope of Services, (1) Description of Services, 1. Scope specifically states LBP inspections shall be conducted “utilizing a NITON-XL, X-Ray Fluorescence (XRF) non-invasive, portable paint analyzer...”
